The Harmonics of Numbers

Although the original author of this manuscript on *Numerology* is not known, I suspect the author to be of *Great Briton* heritage because of the different spellings of some words in the original text such as *colour* and *whilst* plus the double spacing after periods in the sentences. The manuscript was on an old computer disc that was included in a box of books I purchased at a Flea Market many years ago. There was no identification on the outside so it was a month or more before I decided to find out what was on it. It was written in many sections in a hap hazard manner and when I finally decided to put the pieces together in order; I found it to be a very informative manuscript on *Numerology*. I have since taken the liberty to update the text and add some newer interpretations along with a mathematical correction on the use of *Harmonics* rather than *vibrations* to define the relationships in numerology.

The Harmonic Interpretation of Numbers

There was an important *change* that was made within the interpretations of Numerology; the term “*Vibration*” was almost completely *removed* from Numerology’s vocabulary. “*Vibration*” and “*vibrate*” are antiquated terms and were replaced by *Harmonics*. *Numbers* do not create vibrations or vibrate. *Harmonics* do not vibrate they *Oscillate*. Numerological oscillations are created by *standing sine wave* movements. These movements are not traveling waves; they occupy a defined “*length* and *frequency*” and oscillate within the confines of that particular length.

The numbers represented in Numerology are more correctly defined as *Harmonics*. They are derived from what are known as *standing waves*. *Standing waves* obey the mathematics of a *harmonic* sequence known as the *Harmonic Series*.

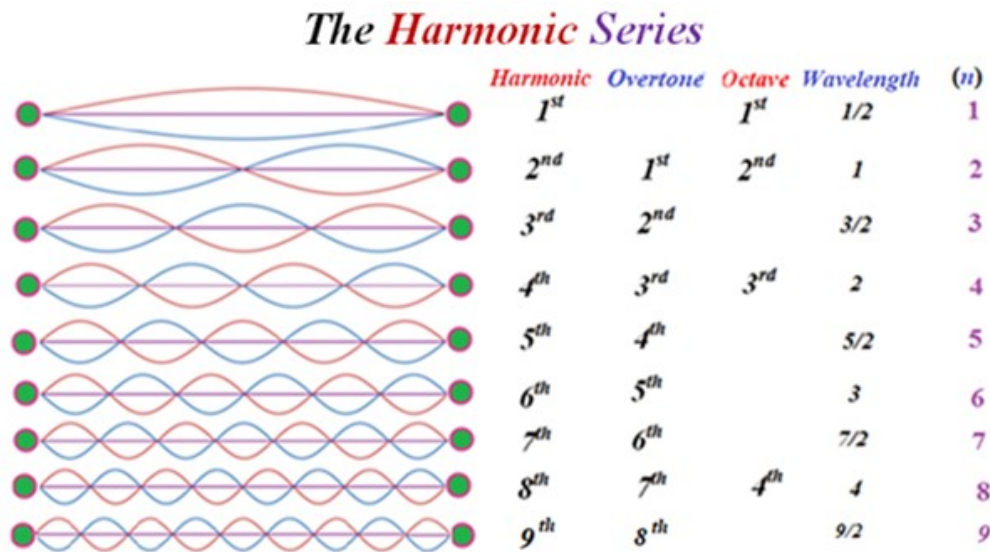
It is defined in mathematics as a sequence of numbers n_1, n_2, n_3 such that their reciprocals or

inverse $\frac{1}{n_1}, \frac{1}{n_2}, \frac{1}{n_3}$, form an *arithmetic sequence*. Its' *series* is shown by the summation

polynomial below.

$$H_n = \sum_{n=1}^{\infty} \left(\frac{1}{n} \right) = \frac{1}{1} + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3} + \frac{1}{4} + \dots + \frac{1}{n} + \dots + \rightarrow \infty$$

Note, on the far right side of the graphic of the *Harmonic Series* shown below; you will see a *header* term labeled (n), which has several uses in harmonics. Numerology uses the (n^{th}) *harmonic* for defining the *Standing Wave* associated with its *Core* numbers one (1) through nine (9). Notice the two *red-circled* green “nodes” on each side of the waves. These are boundaries that keep the oscillations within a certain defined length thus it is termed a “*Standing Wave*”.



The *Harmonic Series* consists of waves or movements whose *frequency* is an *integral* multiple of the frequency of the Fundamental 1st *harmonic's* 1/2 wave. The first set of green nodes above mark the boundaries of the *length* of the Fundamental 1st *harmonic*. All other harmonics are *integral* multiples of the 1st *harmonic's* *wavelength*. Harmonics are *frequency* dependent and a correct frequency could possibly create infinite numbers of harmonics. For a little more in depth insight

into the mathematics of waves and harmonics, I suggest reading **Section 9** of the main manuscript as a prerequisite to this explication. It can be found on my website men-comp.com.

The Updated Text

The origin of Numerology is *timeless*. The seed of the concept of number is buried in the past of pre-historic time. *India* was the birthplace of the ingenious mode of expressing all numbers by means of *ten symbols (0-9)*. Each of these symbols has an absolute value of its own, and in addition, each number has a relative value based on its *position*. The ten symbols and the universal use of the decimal system give testament to the ancient principle: Man is the measure of all things.

Finger counting, on a person's *ten* fingers was probably man's first arithmetic. The ancient Sumerians, the Egyptians, and the Chinese systematically used written numbers. The Chinese considered *odd* numbers to denote *day, white, heat, fire, and sun*. The *even* numbers signified *night, black, cold, matter, water and earth*. They incorporated the *Phoenician* alphabet into their culture, as well as its sounds and letters.

In *India*, the development of the number concept was another place of the origin of the system of giving *evaluation* according to its *position*. This was prior to the discovery of the abacus or counting board, which is still used in some form by children today as a toy or learning tool.

Gematria was the earliest form of *mystic* connotation of numbers. Two values are given to every letter; one of *sound*, one of *number*. Modern Numerologists follow this same pattern today, just as did the writers of the Bible.

The discoveries of the *Pythagoreans* were more numerous. They accepted the *ten* fundamental *Active* and *Passive* oppositions: *odd* and *even, limit* and *unlimited, one* and *many, right* and *left, male* and *female, and motion and rest* and, *straight* and *curved, light* and *darkness, good* and *evil, square* and *oblong*. It was their assertion that the universe is the realization of these *ten oppositions*.

The dependency of intervals on certain *ratios* of lengths of string at the same tension was another discovery of *Pythagoras*. Thus, the ratio *2:1* gives the octave: *3:2* the fifth, and *4:3* the fourth. This

led to the idea that all things are numbers. The *Pythagoreans* assumed the elements of numbers to be the elements of all things and heaven to be a musical scale and a number.

Another subject of study in the school of *Pythagoras* was the nature and quality of numbers. *Even* numbers were considered *soluble*, being *ephemeral*, *feminine*, and pertaining to the *earthly*. *Odd* numbers are *indissoluble*, are *masculine*, and of a *celestial* nature. Each of the numbers was identified with a human attribute, such as 1 with *reason*; 4 with *justice*, which formed the perfect square and being the product of equals.

Philolaus was one of the greatest followers of *Pythagoras* and he reaffirmed all the principles of the school, and summed up his doctrine in the following statement: "All things which can be known have number, for it is not possible that without number anything can be either conceived or known."

Nicomachus, who followed the teachings of the school and founded the philosophy, which flourished in time, bore testimony to the belief in the *mystic* connotations of *Numerology*. This concept is effectively stated in his own words: "All things that have been arranged by nature according to a workman-like plan appear, both individually and as a whole, as singled out and set in order by foreknowledge and reason, which created all according to number, conceivable to mind only and therefore wholly *immaterial*; yet *real*, indeed, the really real, the eternal."

Numerology follows Universal laws, which govern the *Form* of each letter and *number*, contained in your name and birth date. These forms vary according to the *rate* of oscillations of the *harmonics* (which is the basis of all life). Through *Numerology* an understanding of how to separate these *harmonics* not only becomes possible, but can be very enjoyable and beneficial.

From the early days when *Numerology* was taking root until the modern time, a whole tradition has grown up regarding the interpretation of numbers.

The Symbolic/Historical Interpretations of Numbers

Number 1: This number is the symbol of the *cosmos*, or of the *deity*; that it would take an infinite number of steps to evaluate this ratio only lends power to this interpretation, for the infinite, too, is an attribute of God.

Number 2: A *material* principle, according to *Pythagoras*. The second day of the second month of the year was sacred to *Pluto*, and therefore considered unfortunate.

Number 3: A perfect number according to the ancients, it is expressive of the *beginning*, *middle*, and *end*. Mythology ascribed the rule of the world to *three* gods: *Jupiter* [*heaven*], *Neptune* [*sea*] and *Pluto* [*Hades*]. *Jupiter* holds the *three* forked lightning, *Neptune* the *trident*, and *Pluto* the *three*-headed dog.

Number 4: The number of the letters in the word *Lord*, for *God* is the same in countless ancient and modern languages. For example; there are *four* letters for this word in Latin [*Deus*], French [*Dieu*], Assyrian [*Adaf*], Dutch [*Godf*], German [*Gott*], Danish [*Godh*], Persian [*Soru*] and so in Greek, Hebrew, Swedish, Kabbalah, Egyptian, Sanskrit and many others for which words the characters do not exist in English print.

Number 5: This is the *pentad*, or great mystic number, as it is the sum of adding *two*, the first *even* and *three*, the first *odd* number together. (Symbolically) All the powers of nature are contained herein since *1* is unity, *2* diversity, and *three* their compound, hence *5*, all the principles in operation.

Number 6: “*Six* is a *perfect* number in itself, and not because God created all things in *six* days but rather the *inverse* is true: God created all things in *six* days because this number is *perfect*, and it would remain *perfect* even if the work of the *six* days did not exist.” (St. Augustine).

Number 7: *Seven* was considered a *holy* number, for there are *seven* days in creation, *seven* days in the week, and *seven* phases of the Moon. In the Bible, “For *seven* days *seven* priests with *seven* trumpets invested Jericho, and on the *seventh* day they encompassed the city *seven* times.”

Number 8: Is the number of the beatitudes in the Book of Matthew. It is also the symbol of the sign of opposition.

Number 9: A mystical number, being thrice *three*, hence the *perfect* plural. It represents the perfection of *three* or completion.

Studying Numerology allows us to become aware of *ourselves* and our *potential*, to affirm who we are, and to make adjustments based on the information we discover. In seeking to fulfill the old adage "*know thyself*," you will find Numerology to be one of the most simple to use. As your self-awareness increases, Numerology allows you to take a more objective view of yourself; it can help you discern the *overall plan* or *path* that you have chosen.

Acceptance of *yourself* is the very *first* part of *self-esteem*, giving a sense of serenity and a feeling of being grounded. As you compare others' numbers you will see just how *different* they are, or in some cases just how *similar* they are, and just how *differently* each person follows their given path.

The benefit of any teaching is to give you a sense of *perspective* - a sense of your purpose or focus in this life. *Metaphysical* study teaches us to view the *whole picture* (revealing the hidden or non-understandable parts). By seeking these parts we can learn from our experiences of where we have *been* and gain insights into where we are *going*.

Numerology also contains numbers that are defined as *Master Numbers* (11/2, 22/4 and 33/6) and *Malefic Numbers* (13/4, 14/5, 16/7, and 19/1). We will cover these; however, the numbers 1 to 9 are the basis of Numerology, the other numbers are *different* harmonics of these base numbers.

As you go through the Number descriptions keep in mind that each number can be ***Balanced***, ***Under-Balanced*** and ***Over Balanced***.

Balanced is the desired manifestation of the number. It leads us to success and achievement.

Under-Balanced has a lack of the harmonic energy and achieves very little.

Over-Balanced is too much of a 'good thing' and can be quite destructive.

As an example: The Number ***One***: in a ***Balanced*** state is able to confidently influence others with creative ideas and leadership ability. In an ***Under-Balanced*** state, it tends to be subservient, insecure, wavering etc, and does not strive to achieve what is attainable. In an ***Over-Balanced*** state it becomes quite aggressive and antagonistic, wants their own way and will endeavor to get it without thought for others. (***Aggressiveness***).

In this way we can see that the Number **One** can achieve great things if they work with others rather than being stubborn and force someone to do something before they have had enough time to decide whether or not they want to do it just so they can get their own way.

No number stands alone. (The Number **One** probably *thinks* it can). All numbers work with each other, and most of us find that our charts contain all **nine** (9) numbers in some position. So we should never say "I am a **3**" or whatever our Life Path or Expression is. *To become balanced* each number can learn from the one next to it.

The **Number 1** with all its independence and leadership qualities needs to learn the number **2's** balance and co-operation.

The **Number 2** with its sense of love, service and diplomacy needs to learn the Number **3's** gift of self-expression.

The **Number 3** has a love of living and is very enthusiastic about expression itself. However, it often needs to learn discipline from Number **4**.

The **Number 4** is the worker, but can become a bit of a 'stick-in-the-mud.' It can learn from the **5's** sense of freedom and adventure.

The **Number 5** loves freedom and experimentation, but can be a little irresponsible. It can learn responsibility and sense of community from the Number **6**.

The **Number 6** just loves to give, often way too much and the Number **7** can teach it to learn to be alone (without being lonely) and the ability to research and expand their own knowledge.

The **Number 7** can be way too introspective, and with all that knowledge to share can benefit from the constructive tools of the Number **8**.

The **Number 8** has power, authority, and material freedom, but without the humanitarian sense and broadmindedness of the **9**.

The *altruistic 9* gives selflessly, and often to the extreme, forgetting that the self is also important. It can learn from the Number **1!!**

Another point to remember is that no matter where a number sits in a chart the *meaning of the number remains the same*. There are subtle *differences* of course; a number **One** Life Path is that of *Self-reliance* and *Leadership*. For a Personal Year it is *Independence*, *Progression*, *New Initiatives* and *Projects*. For a Soul Urge it is *Independent*, *Assertive* and *Original*. Personality would be *Assertive*, *Independent* and *self-reliant*. And so on. As you can see all aspects of the same energy.

Most people dive into Numerology, working out the calculations with little regard for really 'getting into' the number *harmonics*. Each number has its own *unique* and *special* essence, which gives it its own special '*flavor*'. It is important to spend some time reading over the numbers and trying to get a good feel for each of these *harmonics*.

Remember that with *intuition* just as with the *Tarot* or *Astrology* you will find your own interpretations of the numbers. Look at ten Numerology books and each will be just a little bit different, just as in *Tarot* and *Astrology* there are so many different interpretations for the same card/or aspect. Once you understand the *harmonics* of the number the meanings will flow. This all comes with practice and talking to people, finding out about them when you look at their numbers. Be *flexible* and *intuitive* and it will start to fall into place.

Each chart is a *blueprint* of a life. How we decide to use that blueprint is up to us. *Free Will* is always there. The chart deals with *Potentials*; nothing is carved in stone. Of course, it does seem to go a bit easier when we use the *gifts* and *potential's* we have been given at birth.

Resistance usually just makes us face the same things (*lessons*) over and over. If you have ever noticed that some people seem to make the same mistakes over and over; it is because they are not learning the lesson from the *situations* and *people* presented to them.

The interpretations are personal too, and if you are doing a reading for someone remember not to be too *rigid* and explore both the *positive* and *negative* of the *opposite* of the *harmonics*. i.e., the *number One* may be forceful, self-sufficient and a leader, but this can manifest in a *positive* (*unselfish*) manner or a *negative* (*selfish*) manner. Okay, so now you may be saying, "but I am a **One** Personality or Expression and I am none of those things in the list of number descriptions." How you manifest the energy is very dependent on the *other numbers* in your chart. This is why one should *avoid* discussing only one *aspect* of any *charts*.

There are a few reasons why the number doesn't seem to suit a particular person. They may not have yet activated it, they may have conquered the *harmonics* and it has become *neutral*. Or you may be experiencing the energy through its *opposite*, remember *opposites* comes in cycles. An example of this would be a *One* manifesting through the *Nine* energy, but travelling on their path really well. So instead of a *One* with an upfront *brash* nature you might be a *quiet* very forward moving, independent person. Someone who leads through example, rather than “*Do as I say*” it might be “*Do as I do*”.

Prerequisite Math - Digital Roots

Pythagoras' Numerology, before the modern era, was often termed *Arithmancy*; it was the belief in a divine or mystical relationship between numbers and their effect on human nature. In ancient Greece an *Arithmancer* would assign numerical values to words and phrases and then use the numerical values to predict the future. In simple terms, it was the study of numbers and their influence on humanity. *Arithmancy* incorporated an *ancient* math routine known in the modern era as *Digital Roots*.

Although *ancient* in its first use, the *Digital Root* has its modern beginning within 3rd to 5th grade mathematics in *Elementary* school and makes use of the *Ninth harmonic*. When you were learning to divide, you were introduced to a term called a “*Remainder*.” The remainder in division is the number leftover when the two numbers do not divide evenly. The importance of the *remainder* in elementary division is found within “*Modulo Arithmetic*.” You may not fully recall your 3rd - 5th grade math or *Modulo Arithmetic*, however it is a simple process of division where the *remainder* is the dominant function.

An example of Modulo Arithmetic that gives a *Digital Root* is shown below. It has a *modulus* of the *number nine* (9) where the *remainder* is the *Digital Root*.

$$16 \bmod 9 = \begin{array}{r} 1 \\ 9 \overline{)16} \\ \underline{-9} \\ R7 \end{array} = \text{Digital Root} \\ (1+6) = 7$$

When you use *nine* (9) as the *Modulus* in the calculations it will output the *Digital Root* of any number or *series* of numbers you enter such as a *birth date*.

The *Digital Root* is the basic math operator in *Numerology* relationships. A *Digital Root*, when *calculated manually*, is simply a *successive summation* of the compound numbers encountered within *Numerology* computations. By *successively* summing each compound number, the remaining *single* number is its *Digital Root*. For example the random number 768 below has a *Digital Root* equal to a *single* number *three* (3).

$$768 = (7+6+8) = (21) = (2+1) = 3 \rightarrow \text{"a Successive Summation"}$$

Our English *Alphabet* is also *alphametric*; it is a successive summation of *Digital Roots*.

In the *English* alphabet chart *above*, the alphabetic letters "A" through "I" are the *nine* single numbers (1-9). The letter "J" is the 10th letter in our alphabet; if we take the *Digital Root* of *ten* (10) we get a repeating *one* (1) i.e., $(1+0) = 1$, or in *modulo* arithmetic " $10 \bmod 9 = 1$ " so the letter "J" is placed beneath the *one* (1) column. Another example, the letter "Z" is the 26th letter in our alphabet; its *Digital Root* is $(2+6) = 8$ ($26 \bmod 9 = 8$) so it is placed beneath the 8 column. Repeat this process for each letter and we obtain the *Digital Root* number for each letter in the English alphabet. By using *Digital Roots*, *Arithmancy* or *Numerology* can be universally used in any Language.

Digital Roots are very versatile in that a correct addition of the numbers arranged in any form will give the *exact* same *Digital Root* number; however a *Digital Root* is a different type of *sum* of numbers. We initially form a *sum* of one single compound number's *units* by successively adding each individual number within the compound number. In the following table the versatility of *Digital Roots* will be shown.

Digital Roots of November 7, 2013 (11-07-2013)

1. *November 07, 2013* = $(11+0+7+2+0+1+3) = (24) = (2+4) = 6$
2. *Single digits* $(1+1+0+7+2+0+1+3) = (15) = (1+5) = 6$
3. *Double digits* $(11+07+20+13) = (51) = (5+1) = 6$
4. *Triples & Doubles* $(110+720+13) = (843) = (8+4+3) = (15) = (1+5) = 6$
5. *Fours* $(1,107+2,013) = (3,120) = (3+1+2+0) = 6$

6. *Five's & Triple's* $(11,072+013) = (11,085) = (1+1+0+8+5) = (15) = (1+5) = 6$
7. *Six's & Two's* $(110,720+13) = (110,733) = (1+1+0+7+3+3) = (15) = (1+5) = 6$
8. *Random* $(11+0+7+2013) = (2,031) = (2+0+3+1) = 6$
9. *Random* $(1+10+720+1+3) = (735) = (7+3+5) = (15) = (1+5) = 6$

In regular addition you can also arrange numbers in *any* order and retain the same *sum*. The *Digital Root* is used often to show the numbers that formed the result as in $(1+5) = 6$.

Notice that I used *zeros* in the numbers above. *Zero* does *not* have a harmonic in the *Harmonic Series*. However, anytime you encounter a *zero* in a *Digital Root* compound number, just replace it with the *ninth* (9^{th}) *harmonic* or just the value of the *number nine* (9). Replacing the *zero* (0) with a *nine* (9) will result in the exact same *Digital Root* value. In the examples above I used a *date* which consists of *three* compound number *units* – *Month*, *Day* and *Year*; a specific rule in *Digital Root Numerology* computations is each compound unit is calculated independently of the others. The date was *November 07, 2013*, whose values are 11^{th} month, 07^{th} day, and 2013^{th} year; (*11-07-2013*). We will first calculate the *Digital Root* using the *zero* and then calculate it when the *zero* is replaced by the 9^{th} harmonic or the *number 9*.

$$(11+0+7+2+0+1+3) = (24) = (2+4) = 6$$

$$(11+9+7+2+9+1+3) = (42) = (4+2) = 6$$

Both calculations result in the exact same *Digital Root*. In the above example, I calculated the *three* compound numbers all at once so you would have a contrasting view; however this way is an *incorrect* way. The *correct* way is to calculate the *month*, *day*, and *year* separately, then *sum* the *three* numbers.

$$\text{Month} = \text{November} = (11) = 11$$

$$\text{Day} = 07 = (0+7) = 7$$

$$\text{Year} = 2013 = (2+0+1+3) = 6$$

$$(11+7+6) = (24) = (2+4) = 6$$

Each individual number in the date is calculated separately. Now let's calculate it again substituting the (9^{th}) harmonic for the *zero's* in the individual computations.

$$\text{Month} = \text{November} = (11) = 11$$

$$\text{Day} = 07 = (9+7) = (16) = (1+6) = 7$$

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Year} = 2013 &= (2+9+1+3) = (15) = (1+5) = \mathbf{6} \\ &= (\mathbf{11}+\mathbf{7}+\mathbf{6}) = (24) = (2+4) = \mathbf{6} \end{aligned}$$

We now have *all* our calculations in *terms* of *Harmonics*, bypassing the non-existent *zero* (0) *harmonic*. The result of using either a *zero* (0) or a (9th) *harmonic* will *not* change the final output. The number *nine* is known as *completion*. It is the *largest* single digit that can be obtained from a *Digital Root*. In *Numerology math* it is also known as a *beginning* and *end* because it can be either a 0-dimensional *beginning* or an *ending nine* (9) within *Arithmancy* or *Numerology*.

Notice in the table above, I did not reduce the 11th month *November* to its *Digital Root*. In *Numerology* or philosophical *Arithmancy* the numbers 11, 22, and 33 are known as *Master Numbers* and when used in *Numerology math* are not reduced to a single number, they always retain their original value and are added as such in *Digital Root* calculations. In *Numerology* they are always written as 11/2, 22/4, and 33/6. The *red* numbers 11, 22, and 33 are higher *harmonics* of their *blue Digital Roots* 2, 4, and 6.

The Five (5) Numerology Core Numbers

1. **Life Path** = **Complete Birth Date**
2. **Birth-day** = **Day of the Month of Birth**
3. **Expression Number** or **Destiny Number** = **Full Name**
4. **Heart's Desire** or **Soul's Urge** = **Vowels in Full Name**
5. **Personality** = **Consonants in Full Name**

Digital Root of Birth-Days

1 st , 10 th , 19 th , or 28 th = (1)	5 th , 14 th , or 23 rd = (5)

The Numbers**Number 0**

Zero is used as a *composite* number in Numerology. It stands for all that was before creation; therefore, it stands for *Deity*, pure *Spirit*, Divine *Light*, that which *was*, *Is*, and *Shall be*, It is also described as *Omniscient Deity*, *First Cause*, the *I am*, the *All-seeing-Eye*, *Fountain of Eternal Life*, the *Will*, *Super-Consciousness*, *Protection*, *Perfection*, and *Love*.

The **Zero** does not add or subtract *qualities* in a situation, but is *redemptive*, as it raises the qualities by a power of **10**; for example, **1** is raised to **10**, **2** to **20**, **3** to **30**, and so forth.

People whose name or birth date numbers are expressed as *digits* plus **Zero**, **10**, **20**, **30** etc. show more initiative. They go forward with confidence because of the *protection* and Divine *Consciousness* of the **Zero**. The **Zero** represents *Deity*, *Spirit*, and Divine *Light*; and the *All*; the *Absolute*, *unity*, Creative *Power*. Rather than adding to or subtracting from the qualities of another digit, it raises those qualities by a level of **10**. The **Zero** adds Divine *protection*; thus people whose numbers are expressed as a *digit* plus **Zero**, show *initiative* and *confidence*.

The **100** level of consciousness is *insight illumination*. All souls have to progress to regain the God-Image, which was **ONE** in the beginning.

Zero is not really considered a number in Numerology as you can't be a **0 Life Path** or *Expression*, however it does have a place when looking at *composite* numbers such as **10**, **20**, **30** and so on. Symbolically the **Zero** represents the Cosmic *Egg*, the primordial *Androgyne*. **Zero** as an empty circle depicts both the nothingness of death and yet the totality of life contained within the circle. As an *ellipse* the two sides represent *ascent* and *descent*, *evolution* and *involution*.

Before the **ONE** (the Source, not the number) there was only Void, or nothingness; the ultimate mystery, the incomprehensible *Absolute*. The absence of all *quality* or *quantity*.

Words such as Non-existence; nothingness; the unmanifest; the unlimited; the eternal are apt descriptions. In Taoism it symbolizes the void; non-being. Buddhism symbology tells us it is the Void and no-thingness. Kabbalistic culture considers it as Boundless; Limitless Light; the *Ain*. *Pythagoras* saw **Zero** as the *perfect*, and the *Monad*, the *originator* and container of all. Islamic culture shows **Zero** as the Divine *Essence*.

Sacred Geometry considers **0** to be emptiness. All creation begins with a void; a blank space. It is an empty set full of potentials waiting to be realized. It has no identity, and no personal existence. The number of emptiness is **zero** - easily the most mysterious of the numbers. It is misunderstood because it can't be grasped directly. It is not a thing; therefore has no geometry. It is unknowable, yet every number and form rests on it. The void is the static foundation upon which all rests.

It represents the origin of all things and at the same time the limit to reach the starting point and the point of arrival of a cycle - illustrating the paradoxical identity of the non-being and the plenitude to be it, according to *Abellio*. It is a perfect number, expressing the totality, therefore the universe, according to the Low Mesopotamia.

It is a valueless numerical sign by itself, but holding the place of absent values in the numbers. Only by its *position*, it confers to others more value, the zero multiplying by **10** the numbers placed at its left. It symbolizes the person who has value only by delegation. Its form of notation, which is circular, considers the zero as a symbol of unity and also of eternity. In Egypt, no hieroglyph corresponds to it.

The Number One

Leader, independent, courageous, achiever, strength, creative, attainment, adventurous, inventive, powerful, changeable, boastful, impatient, bossy, insecure.

The number **One** symbolizes beginning or initiation. It signifies a person must learn to stand-alone, be assertive, and achieve recognition. The **One** is ambitious, achieving, and prefers to demonstrate its own ideas. Self sufficient, inventive, strong willed and dominant, the **One** wants to establish individuality; make a name for itself. The **One** can be stubborn, egotistical, blunt, overly

ambitious, impulsive, and domineering. The **One** hates to be overlooked, and not using his/her own talents.

The **One** is singular and strong as the keywords suggest. It is the basis of all the other numbers. **One's** make good writers, directors, inventors, presidents (of companies/countries), public figures, and proprietors.

The **One** energy is *masculine*, *focused* and *rational*. **One** is the *Ego* number. The name Adam harmonizes to the number **One**, its first letter too harmonizes to the number **One**, and he was the first man of the Bible!

The Number Two

Partner, diplomat, friend, artist, enduring; Peacemaker, gentle, insightful, sensitive. Balance, harmony, charm, and Duality.

The number **Two** symbolizes the principle of *coming together* with another, and is interested with partnership. The **Two** person is generally *supportive* and *diplomatic* and likes *intimacy*. The **Two** is aware of other's needs as well as its own, and strives to demonstrate *friendliness*, *understanding* and *tact*. The **Two** tends to be *artistic*, *shy*, *thorough*, and *analytical*. The **Two** is full of love and service; it has beautiful *charm*, *gentleness*, *patience* and liking for *detail* and *order*. **Two** is artistic and extremely sensitive to the *thoughts* and *feelings* of *others*. **Two's** can become too *critical*, *indifferent*, *discontent*, and/or have displays of *temper*. The **Two** likes money and possessions and often becomes a collector of antiques, jewelry and works of art or plants. If the **Two** becomes more decisive with conviction and purpose, many opportunities will arise.

The **One** is singular and strong with keywords that jump out at you. The **Two** doesn't have this impact. It is more *flowing*; *adaptable*, *tactful*, a follower, seeker of *harmony*, and also *indecisive*. The **Two** is the most gentle number, but it can be the power behind the throne, and makes a good back up for the **One**. A lot of **One** employers/leaders surround themselves with **Two's**.

The **Two** tends to avoid *disharmony* at all costs, often trying a little too hard. *Indecision* can rear its head when they need to take a definite action that will affect others. The **Two** always considers

both sides; and that is the main job of the *Two*. The *Two* can be very *shy* and *insecure* in the negative.

Unfortunately in relationships they may forget their own needs in favor of the needs of others. This can lead to a lifetime of *unmet* needs if the *Two* is very insecure. *Balance* and *harmony* begin within, and the *Two* will eventually learn that inner balance means they must consider their own needs as well as everyone else's. Beware of becoming dependent on others or others becoming too dependent on you.

Two's are here to teach inner balance, harmony, and the ability to compromise. *Two's* enjoy beauty in all forms. The number *Two* has the wonderful quality of seeing both sides of any situation; this is where the procrastination comes in. Its not a bad thing, but there is a need to be aware of it. *Two's* are also quite *intuitive*, so knows more than others are telling it. Sometimes this can lead to others being just a little uncomfortable when you say something they think you shouldn't know.

The *One* said, "*I am*" the *Two* says, "*I am not alone*". *Two 's* make good artists, technicians, psychologists, spouses, healers, bookkeepers, and coordinators. *Two* is the *subservient* number. The *Two* energy is *feminine*, and quite *mental*.

The Number Three

Optimist, creative, social, easygoing, Visionary, humorous, energetic, and spontaneous; Self-expression.

The number *Three* symbolizes the principle of growth. It shows the initiation force of the *One* and the germinating energy of the *Two* bearing fruit. It signifies a *synthesis* is present - that of imagination and an outpouring of energy is in action. *Three* is optimistic and *fun loving*, and strives to uplift and color it surroundings. *Three* energy is enlivening, youthful and enthusiastic. It has the gifts of enthusiasm, imagination and is versatility. *Three* strives to enjoy life, stay young and play.

One thrives on self-will. *Two* thrives on compromise and harmony. *Three* thrives on enjoying what *One* and *Two* have created. *Three* enjoys it, and more importantly, expands it.

Three has a strong faith in the future with its optimistic, outgoing attitude. **Three** is considered to be the number of the *entertainer*; and who would need more faith? Tremendous faith is required to put yourself up in front of an audience of people and offer yourself and your talent to be accepted or rejected.

Of course, *luck* is just another way of saying *faith*. **Three** knows that *luck* is *created*; with attitude and expectations. **Three** doesn't care about what happened in the past. The future is where they want to be, and where the mind usually is. **Three** teaches us to take what we have and expand it beyond what was thought possible. **Three** teaches faith in tomorrow and pleasure in today.

Three has a talent for being extremely well organized and great enthusiasm for projects will hold fascination with them. **Three** has a knack of making others see their point of view, which makes them very successful salespeople; and promoters of new schemes. **Three** adapts very well to others; but can be a bit too *talkative*. Because of their infectious good nature others usually don't mind it.

Three can be excessively independent which can offend others as it often comes across as *indifference*. **Three** can sometimes brush aside other's ideas and projects, as it tends to be solely interested in it's own schemes. **Three** can unfortunately swing between over-confidence and self-doubt, which may cause failure in seeing a project through. Often if a project is not completed as quickly as **Three** would like, **Three** tends to abandon it rather than see it through. The **One** said, "*I am*" the **Two** says, "*I am not alone*": **Three** says, "*I create*".

Three's make good motivators, coaches, writers, musicians, artists, parents, salespeople, and communicators in all types of media. **Three** is the Social and self-expression number. The **Three** energy is *masculine*.

The Number Four

Practical, application, determination, serious; Builder, doer, manager, traditional, Foundations.

The number **Four** symbolizes the *principle* of putting ideas into *form*. It signifies *work* and *productivity*. The **Four** is constructive, realistic, traditional and cautious. It is the number of system, order and management.

One and *Two* have made new beginnings and balanced them out. *Three* came along and through sheer will and faith, expands and give meaning to what *One* and *Two* started. And then along came *Four*.

Looking at the keywords for *Four* we see *builder* and stable *grounded*. They are rock solid. *Four* harmonizes to the element of *Earth*. *Four* is a doer, it wants to build something. It looks around and says "This is all very nice, there is a lot of growth and creativity, but no structure. I have to do something about it." *Four* says that ideas are great, but don't waste them; Do Something With Them!

Four has no time for ideas, which have no *functional* use in the *material* world. It wants rules, regulations, and laws for everything. An overdose of *Four* brings us a very narrow path to walk from which we would not dare to stray. An under-dose of *Four* brings us chaos. It reminds us that there is an order to the Universe, and the laws, which govern life on this planet. *Four* enforces these laws, or at the very least makes us aware of them. We can escape them for a short while but eventually we have to come back and replenish our supply of the things we need to survive.

Four is here to build solid structures from the ideals and dreams of others. *Four* makes things real and practical. *Four* is reliable, punctual, orderly, systematic, methodical and precise. *Four* needs predictability, it likes habits and rituals. *Four* can be rigid and dislikes change. *Four* provides the basis to every enterprise. *Four* must guard against being too exacting and a little too dominant. As *Four* likes to do the right thing it must guard against expecting others to do the same to the extreme. *Four* must guard against becoming superior, and learn to take the blame for its own mistakes. They must learn to be their own person as often become bogged down with convention in relation to family, relationships, etc.

The *One* said "*I am*", the *Two* says "*I am not alone*", the *Three* says "*I create*", the *Four* says "*I am safe*".

Four's make good builders, constructors and organizers. They make good employees in buying and selling, administration, agencies, employment, promoters of education, and are drawn to careers to do with papers, documents contracts, law affairs, property sales and rental, earth scientist, business owners. *Four* is the *Work* number.

The Number Five

Progress, freedom, activity, influence; Adventurer, sensualist, promoter, flair, inquisitive, assertive, restlessness.

The number *Five* symbolizes the principle of *multiplicity*, *progression*, and *passion*. It signifies the need for *change*, *variety*, and new *growth*. It is the *broadcaster* -- collecting information and asking questions. It is a public number; outgoing, fast moving, and mercurial. It wants to discover new things. *Five* is full of life.

Ask *Five* about *Four*. *Five* will giggle and roll its eyes. *Five* will say "*Boring*". *Five* is here to break down structure. Its keywords are *change*, *freedom*, *intellect*, *communication*, and *breakdown of established structures*.

Five is bored. *Four* has built too many structures and has created far too many rules. *Five* thinks that rules were only made for one reason! And *Five* is here to do just that. *Five* has a reputation for being an unstable number. Here again is the element of *Air*, which is intellectual and mental.

Five will find a weak point in a law or structure that has been made, and blast it away. *Five* wants freedom not limits and commitment. *Five* wants to experience new things, new ideas and new people, not the same old, same old. *Five* doesn't mean to be unstable; it's just that too much stability can lead to lack of growth. Too much of being stuck in the same way of thinking can prevent us from reaching new heights.

Five intends to teach us the safety of the *Four* must sometimes be left behind in favor of risking new experiences, which help us to grow. The number *Five* symbolizes the *five* senses which allows you to explore and experience new things.

Five is a dynamic number, maybe the most dynamic of the numbers. It is courageous; willing to break new ground. It can juggle many projects at once. It also has a reputation for being "*hyper*". It's like the *A*-type personality. Always on the move. Number *Five* really is alive.

An inner restlessness causes the *Five* to look for different and new things. Monotony is death. If forced to live a life of routine *Five* can become *sullen*, *unhappy*, *restless*, *impatient*, *critical*, *over-emotional*, and maybe even *eccentric*, and can then seemingly lack the application to make a

success of life. The **Five** can be a leader, not because of its organizational qualities, but because it can keep things moving.

The **One** said "*I am*" the **Two** says "*I am not alone*", the **Three** says "*I create*", the **Four** says "*I am safe*", the **Five** says "*I discover*".

Five's make newspaper reporters, columnists, and novelists. They also do well in publicity, advertising, and travel. Also Lawyers, politicians, and governmental officials. Entertainment such as amusement, theatre and sports interest **Five**. **Five** can be a good salesperson. **Five** likes speculation, but should be wary of gambling as the Law of probability always operates in money affairs. **Five** is the *Change* and *Freedom* number.

The Number Six

Service, domestic, responsible, careful, Teacher, conventional, provider, healer.

The number **Six** symbolizes the principle of *nurturing*, *caring*, and *harmony*. It signifies the need for stability and a solid home base with comfort. It is the *teacher*, *trainer* and *parent*. It is happiest in conventional or familiar surroundings and is *opinionated* and *frugal* or *anxious* when insecure. Rarely selfish, it may take on the burdens of others unnecessarily. It loves tradition, and is health oriented. **Six's** keywords just seem to glow all over them. *Emotional*, *sensitive*, family *responsibilities* and *compassion*.

Six has a need to teach us that we are stronger united than we would be alone. Caring for family, both personal and universal, because it is the only way that they will stay safe. They are natural healers and quick to get into service-oriented professions. **Six** is a natural counselor, is very intuitive about what people are all about inside, and a natural empathy.

Problems only crop up for **six** when it does too much for others and forgets about its own needs. Emotional bonds to others is life sustaining; total dependence on others is *life draining*. **Six** is here to teach us all how to care for each other. **Six** also has to learn how to let go and let others care for themselves.

The number **Six**, is often called the "*Cosmic Parent*" (because of the aspects of Universal love, compassion, sympathy and peace) and is a born adviser, idealistic, conscientious, poised,

devoted, and dedicated to *home* and *family* life. The *Six* is *honorable* in service, and *responsible* towards others. It enjoys the company of others, and has a calming effect. It must also guard against giving advice when it is not asked for, and trying not to get too personal which may cause tendencies of *egotism*, *suspicion* and *jealousy*. Others will only grow when they learn by their own mistakes, so it must be careful not to point out mistakes in others.

The *One* said "*I am*" the *Two* says "*I am not alone*", the *Three* says "*I create*", the *Four* says "*I am safe*", the *Five* says "*I discover*", the *Six* says "*I stand up for myself*".

Six's make good parents, educators, caterers, nurses, health workers, counselors, and coaches. *Six* is the *Responsibility* and *Adjustment* Number.

The Number Seven

Investigation, specialist, inventor, loner, eccentric, thoughtful, spiritual, reclusive, intellectual, the mystic, the prophet.

The number *Seven* symbolizes humanity's deep inner need to find *depth*, *meaning*, and *spiritual connection*. When the person's needs of food, self-expression, material and domestic achievements have been met, we turn to the deeper levels of life - to learn, to educate ourselves and to find purpose. The *Seven* is an investigator, an inventor, and must have *solitude* in which to find the *inner voice*.

Having banded together in a country or family under the *Six*, we then break away and walk our own path when the *Seven* comes along. Don't think that the *Seven* doesn't care about others. It does, but in the most spiritual sense. The *Seven* can't think what to do about all the things which threaten humanity while it is drowning in all the feelings and problems of the individual. *Seven* wants to grow *spiritually*, not just *emotionally* or *financially*. It wants to go within from time to time and think about what the meaning of life is. *Seven* wants to see the *BIG Picture*. *Seven* really needs a lot.

Seven doesn't want to socialize and get to know you at a picnic. *Seven* wants to be left *alone* and analyze what is wrong with this planet on a *soul* level, and what can and should be done about it.

Seven obviously has a lot to teach us but you can find yourself wishing it would just occasionally 'lighten up'. We need the philosophical insights of **Seven**, we need the analytical commitment to finding the answers to planetary problems, and we need the reminders that spiritual growth is where it is really at. **Seven** can teach us that, but we need to convince **Seven** to come down from its ivory tower and share this with us. **Seven** has exceptional psychic and clairvoyant abilities.

The **One** said "*I am*" the **Two** says "*I am not alone*", the **Three** says "*I create*", the **Four** says "*I am safe*", the **Five** says "*I discover*", the **Six** says "*I stand up for myself*", the **Seven** says "*I am mature*".

Sevens make good consultants, professors, analysts, individualists, observers, occultists. **Seven** is the *Wisdom* number.

In my experience I have found that the **seven** is, indeed, a magical/mystical number...full of ancient wisdom just waiting to be brought into the conscious mind. In my opinion, perhaps the most spiritual of our numbers. If prodded, the **seven** can become a great teacher of the unknown and unexplored. On the other side of that coin, I have found that it deals with alcoholism (whether its own or those around it) or absolute sobriety, hypoglycemia (extreme mood swings), depression and melancholia...even paranoia (this usually as a result of the hypoglycemia). It is the number of the *loner*...works well by itself and is not lonely. The **seven Life Path** has many ups and downs, - rich one day and poor the next - happy one day and out of it the next. The pursuit of the *material* and *spiritual* lives must be in balance as well as the *physical* and *emotional*. The **seven** has layers and layers of protection around itself. Each time it is hurt, it withdraws further into those layers. It is difficult to really know a **seven** because they don't allow the real self to show very often for fear of rejection or being hurt.

The Number Eight

Power, executive, professional, strength, money; problem solver, organizer, achiever, judgment.

The number **Eight** symbolizes the principle of *domination*, *control*, and *achievement*. It is the executive decision-maker. The **eight** tends to be rather *formal*, *stern* and *hardheaded*. More comfortable in the realm of *material*, tangible facts, the **eight** will be truly exceptional as soon as it

develops its spiritual connection and intuition. A *natural leader*, it will have a good grasp of how to accomplish any goal, however it must learn compassion.

The keywords for *eight* read like an ad to fill a position of a stockbroker. It is *responsible, powerful*, has *financial* and *business* sense, *authority* and [the ever popular] *Karma*.

You probably have worked out that the element of *Earth* is involved here. *Four* doesn't come close to the hyper-responsible *eight's* ambitions and possessing the good business judgment to achieve what it desires. The *eight* sets out to rule the world. It will be no surprise that *eight* is the number of government, big business, executives and other assorted people in positions, whether real or assumed.

The good old *Karma* comes along when *eight* gets a little carried away. If power and authority is used in a responsible and just fashion it gets a big *OKAY* from the universe. Someone has to be the boss, get things organized and keep it that way until the job is done. Doing this noble and time-consuming job is a long way removed from abusing others in your position of authority. Like a cosmic punch in the nose? Use your power and authority in a way, which deprives others the right to choose their own path and see what happens.

Eight teaches about the proper use of power, and what can happen to us if we abuse it. This is an important lesson for those in leadership positions, either in government or in a family. *Eight* has great gifts of decisiveness, courage, focus and delegation.

The *One* said, "*I am*" the *Two* says, "*I am not alone*", the *Three* says, "*I create*", the *Four* says, "*I am safe*", the *Five* says, "*I discover*", the *Six* says, "*I stand up for myself*", the *Seven* says, "*I am mature*", the *Eight* says, "*I master*".

Eight's make good professionals, business owners, publishers, contractors, engineers, financial analysts, and judges.

The number has such a strong pattern of power, it tends to want things to go its own way and has a tendency to want to take charge of others lives. Of course some may appreciate being 'rescued' and the tower of strength it offers, but sometimes there is a risk of co-dependent relationships being set up here. And these can be quite one-sided. When the *eight* can let go of the need to take over and control it does develop relationships that are equal without power struggles making them more meaningful and peaceful.

An interesting side of the *eight* is *karma*. Everything that is sown will be reaped. The *eight* has so much to give with its organizational skills and on top of that it has very good judgment. Many people who have an *eight Karmic Lesson* can be quite successful. *Eight* is the *Material* number.

The Number Nine

Universal, generalist, multi-talented, teacher; humanitarian, healer, artist, old-soul, actor.

The number *Nine* symbolizes the principle of universal *philosophy* or *consciousness*. It is the dreamer, and feels at home in the realm of the arts, medicine, religion, drama, and philosophy and metaphysics. It is a healer and educator, acting always for the benefit of others. The *Nine* looks for solutions from the *inspirational*, *intuitive*, and *creative* worlds. Its energy is loving, compassionate, diffuse, and global.

Eight can get pretty hooked on personal power and forget sometimes that we're *ALL* merely channels for the *REAL* power. *Nine* usually doesn't need reminding that we're personally powerless without the help of our Higher Power. *Nine* is the number, which connects us all to each other. Like a silver thread, *Nine* weaves us all together and makes us accountable for what happens to our brothers and sisters on this planet.

Nine remembers that we have been taught if our brother or sister needs our shirt, we give them our coat as well. *Nine* takes us a step beyond the material planes or even the plane of thoughts and ideas. *Nine* gently guides us toward the realization that we are not only with each other, but also with the Power which created us.

Nine is the number of *endings*. Ok, so no one usually likes endings, but of course each ending brings forth a new beginning, something to look forward to. Without endings some things just wouldn't happen. *Nine* is the number of the *mystic*.

When *Nine* enters there is a change in substance. You can add the qualities of the *Nine* to any of the numbers and they are totally changed in substance, yet totally unchanged in form. *Nine* involves us in "actions" which take us "*across*" and "*beyond*" the inner "substance" of what we were before, yet leaves us gently unchanged. We are the same; but we are on a new level of consciousness. Observe the *nine* in action- $(5+9)=14 \rightarrow (1+4)=5$.

Nine needs to learn that there is nothing spiritual about allowing ourselves to be taken advantage of. It is a worthy goal, helping others, but **Nine** can tend to slip into the role of victim. It's okay to say "no" occasionally, and it can actually be the most helpful thing one can do for those they love most.

Nine wants to teach about unconditional love and how to let go in the same way. It teaches us that when all is said and done, the real source of our happiness and strength is the invisible Higher Power. **Nine** wants us to know that we are all individual expressions of that Higher Power.

The **One** said "*I am*" the **Two** says "*I am not alone*", the **Three** says "*I create*", the **Four** says "*I am safe*", the **Five** says "*I discover*", the **Six** says "*I stand up for myself*", the **Seven** says "*I am mature*", the **Eight** says "*I master*", the **Nine** says "*I and others are One*". **Nines** make good Ministers, occultists, health workers, counselors, artists, world/community leaders. **Nine** is the *Humanitarian* number.

MASTER NUMBERS

Master numbers are higher *harmonics* of numbers which have to be *Mastered*, not numbers which make us a Master. We must work our way there and *earn* them. These numbers indicate what potential we *MAY* have if we *choose* to grow into them. The *harmonics* itself has the "*Master Quality*". *Free will* allows us to choose whether or not we want to grow into them. It is our choice. The special qualities they have are not automatically *activated* at our birth. When you come across a **Master number** (11, 22, or 33) in a chart, you should write them as such 11/2, 22/4, and 33/6.

Sometimes **Master numbers** can cause a lot of problems if they are being worked in the *negative*, when someone is not ready to deal with them. It is very hard to live up to your highest potential and people usually become irritated with the world as a sense of frustration overwhelms them. People with **Master numbers** often are extremely *sensitive* and *highly-strung* with *eccentric* and/or *erratic* behavior, which is hard to understand. **Master numbers** can make life very difficult. If the inner drive is there (the "*pressure cooker effect*"), but the *opportunities* or the *effort* to pursue their potential is not, the result is often emotional turmoil, low self-esteem, a lack of direction, health problems, and chaos. Very few people with **Master numbers** among their core numbers manage to tap into their true potential before age 30 to 45.

When you delineate the chart, give the interpretations for the base number first, that is the 2, 4, or 6, and then work to the *Master number*. This way a person can see where they are and where they are capable of going. *Honesty* is important here. Sometimes we just *aren't* ready or willing to work with the *Master numbers* and work only with the base numbers. The base numbers have to be *mastered* first before the *Master numbers* can be activated. Whichever is chosen is fine.

There is nothing wrong with pointing out what *potential* an individual has. The keyword here being *POTENTIAL*. But always remember that these powerful energies which can bring so much good can also have very strong downsides, causing *physical* ailments and *nervous* conditions.

A guide to whether or not to use *Master numbers* in a chart is if life revolves around *earthly* and *egotistical* energies there is a good chance that the base *harmonic* is being worked on. But if thoughts revolve around *metaphysical* and *philosophical* concepts you could be operating at the *Master number* level.

The qualities of *Master numbers* often come through as *intuition*, as feelings of *knowingness* or *intuition* from *higher levels*. Some people may just feel lucky. *Master numbers* do not mean a person is more spiritual or better than someone who does not have master numbers.

The *Master numbers* 11, 22, and 33 represent a triangle. A triangle of *Enlightenment*.



The number 11 represents the vision.

The number 22 combines vision with action

The number 33 offers guidance to the world.

The number 33 as a core number is very rare. Those who have a 33 as a core number and tap into the enhanced potential, always make an impact on the lives of many people. They are the ultimate teachers. There are probably less than 100 people alive at any time who play such a role as a result of the 33 in their chart. There are, of course, many more great teachers. However, their motivations, spiritual strength, and source of knowledge flows from other aspects found in their charts.

11/2 = Idealist, artist, celebrity, highly energized; Inspiration, psychological, radical, sensitive.

The number **11** symbolize the principle of enlightenment. It colors everything with drama, a visionary outlook, artistic sensitivity, and a sparkling quality. It is not very practical, but its contribution is its unique perspective and *philosophy* which instigates new consciousness. Its energy is very *high-strung*, *intense*, *mercurial*, *polarized*, and *subtle*.

People with **11** in their numerology charts are believed to have very strong *intuition*, heightened sensitivity, and a deep connection to the universe. They often feel as though they have a higher purpose in life and are driven by a sense of spiritual mission.

11 is the first even-digit *palindrome* (It is the same read either forward or backward) and the only palindromic *prime* among them; all such palindromes are multiples of **11**. The **11** aims to reveal higher truths, cause transformation and has a gift for poetic interpretation. It must overcome *illusion*, *isolation*, *allergies*, and *overstimulation*. When your birth date gave you the number **11**, it was more than just a random occurrence – it's an awakening message. It's like pecking taps on the shoulder, it's reminding you to pay attention to your *intuition*. Often, number **11's intuition** appears out of nowhere. It's the universe's way of saying, "Hey, pay attention." This number signifies that you should connect with your *gut feeling*. It's an inner reminder to tune into the mind and realize there are changes on the way. One of the key messages of number **11** is to *trust your intuition*. Your *gut feeling*, that inner voice you sometimes hear, is a powerful alarm clock in your life. This number reminds you that your *intuition* is your most valuable asset, one that can lead you toward greater enlightenment. It encourages you to listen to your inner mind and follow your instincts. By doing so, you can weave your way through life with confidence and clarity, making better choices along the way.

On normal days **11** harmonizes to its *Digital Root 2*. On days when its full nature is sensed it is an energy that translates a world beyond.

22/4 = *Master Builder*, producer, manager, abundance; Inspiration, exemplar, large-scale organizer. The number **22** symbolizes the principle of applying higher consciousness to practical problems. Affecting a large area or group of the population, the **22** puts into effect changes in the *material* standard of living. The natural ability to plan, direct, and maintain at a high level of competency is increased with the double digit because the person is working with inspiration from a higher *harmonic* source. Its energy is goal-oriented, inexhaustible, and powerful. The **22** has gifts

of vision, strategy, enthusiasm and perseverance. It wants to raise standards everywhere; to follow a mission.

On normal days **22** becomes a **4**. When the full capacity as a Master Builder is sensed it can achieve what is barely imaginable.

33/6....*Master Healer*, inspired teacher. The number **33** symbolizes the principle of self-sacrificing love and commitment. It is very concerned for family traditions, the welfare of large numbers of people, and is extremely responsible. This number is often called the *Christ* number because of its ability to love completely and without condition (and because Christ died at age **33**). Its energy is explosive if not understood and channeled, and is used best if there is a spiritual profession.

The **33** aims to bring change to all levels of society, and has gifts in sacrifice, nurturance, harmonizing conflicts. It must first set aside personal ambition and health.

Karmic Numbers.

Another little group of numbers, which are worth noting are what are called *Karmic* or *Malefic* numbers. These numbers are an important part of numerological charting. What they actually indicate is an abuse in another time that is to be balanced in this life. Those who abused the natural laws in past experiences will have to pay back these debts. They are significant when found in any of the key positions, such as *Life Path*, *Soul Urge*, *Expression*, *Challenge*, and to somewhat a lesser degree the *Day of Birth*.

In effect *Karmic Numbers* are especially related to compound numbers for those who believe in past lives and re-incarnation. For every wrong you did in a previous life you must pay a price for your *malefic* behavior, whether it is in this lifetime or a future lifetime. You are also obligated to pay for past lifetimes if not already paid. It is similar to the *first* rule of *Alchemy*; which states that before you can obtain something you must give up something else of equal value. The two are worded differently but actually have the same effect. In one way or another you are going to pay for *malefic* behavior.

For those who don't believe in re-incarnation it is explaining the relationship between the *two* numbers that create a *Digital Root*, as in sixteen (**16**), which is $(1+6) = 7$.

Although they are called *Malefic* (malicious), they are actually *reconstructive*, for they have lessons to teach which can lead you to gain necessary experiences. They are an indication that life must be adjusted so that the weakness does not continue to cause you problems. So the key here is to remember that "there are *no bad* numbers".

While any reconstruction period can seem like a calamity while the effects of the *harmonics* are felt, the tests or trials it brings are actually good for you. One of the cosmic laws states that you must pay for transgressions you have committed.

13/4 = Rebirth, transformation, re-patterning

If we look at the **13th** card of the Tarot, we see Death. Death may be feared because of uncertainty of what is beyond the grave. The actual interpretation of course does not mean the end of life but *change, motion, or transformation*. Change is an inspirational new beginning. The thirteenth card or karmic number merely signifies that death is a new change in consciousness in the current lifetime.

Through superstition the number **13** came into ill repute. It is really a good period of regeneration. The keyword is *work* on the *material* plane. The warning given is that of the danger of *backsliding* into *laziness, negativity, and inefficiency*. Trials and tests of proficiency will be given on the *material* plane, and *work* is the solution. It warns against being *indifferent, discontented, and ill mannered*.

Before the time of Jesus, **13**, was considered to be a positive power and good omen. The negativity toward the number is believed to have come from the fact that there were **13** people present as the "*Last Supper*", and one of the **13** betrayed Jesus. Before this, it was one of the most revered numbers, but considered so *holy* and *unapproachable* that it began to be feared and shunned.

If it has any destructive power it is because of the negative thought surrounding it for so many centuries. For those who have mastered it, it is constructive and fortunate.

Its sum is **4**, but behind it is the **1** and the **3**, is insistence upon the Path of Dalliance (wasting time), when the goal is work and construction. Its warning is the backsliding into laziness and negativity. One must learn to step from triviality into a **4-square-** type of construction. Its slogan is *Work* on the *material* plane.

The roots of the **13** lies in the individual to really apply himself or herself to work and everything that goes with it. This number may surface in the life as workaholism and the tendency to see problems in everything. You may also be very critical of yourself and hard to live with because you expect to much from yourself and others.

Note: Always consider the *Digital Root* base numbers *first* (**4, 5, 7, & 9**) when looking at the *karmic* numbers, sometimes the Karma has been repaid.

If **13** is found as the *Expression* Number, it indicates you may be in the habit of expressing laziness and negativity to people around you. You should work toward constructive expression, optimistic outlook, practice smiling, (which is great fun) and learn to laugh. Stop working so hard to avoid working. Find the brighter side of any situation you find yourself in, and most importantly be constructive and productive.

13 as a *Soul Urge* number, indicates that there is a danger of backsliding into laziness and negativity, when the ultimate goal is *work*. The slogan here is work on the material plane; you must put your back into it and build a good foundation in the work area.

If found as the *Personality* number, there are indications that you may be in the habit of expressing laziness and negativity to people around you. You should work toward constructive expression, and an optimistic outlook to life. Find the bright side of any situation you find yourself in; and most importantly be constructive and productive.

When found as the *Life Path* number, it indicates that this is largely a path of work and service to others. You should learn self-discipline, make yourself do what needs to be done, build a firm foundation for your future that will last. Prosperity and success lies in learning the value of work, system, and routine, along with dependability and patience. Build for others as well as yourself and set an example of discipline.

14/5 = addiction, freedom, passion.

This represents physical possessions. It warns of loss of property and failure in business. It is hard for a **14** to learn these lessons, because one often tries to gain freedom by destructive methods at the expense of others. This brings loss, sickness and heartache. Too interested in physical senses. It is also called the number of *experience*.

It is associated with the constructive use of freedom. It focuses on the **five** senses, there is a tendency to over-eat, over-drink, and cross the 'normal' boundaries of sexual exploration. This number learns how to be in the earthly, sensual world without losing touch with the spiritual connection. It learns how to enjoy life and the challenges of freedom of choice without getting stuck in overindulgence and wastefulness. It learns to follow through on promises without feeling; it is giving away its time or power. There is too much passion, conflict, and resistance to control. Its title is "*Waters of Lethe*".

If **14** is found as the *Soul Urge*, then there will be many emotional upsets and delays. Your **soul** finds it difficult to remember and profit by experience. This is the tendency, which can be overcome by learning from all the experiences in this lifetime whether you feel they are good experiences or not. Remember there is always a lesson to be learned from everything that happens to us though our lives.

If **14** is found as the *Expression* number, then many disappointments and losses will be encountered. It is mostly concerned with physical passions and overindulgence. In order to reach your goals you should develop self-discipline and stick-to-it-ness. There is an indication of excessive food, drink, sex, (the **five** physical senses). Work hard in this lifetime to gain a balance, and learn to use and not abuse.

As the *Personality*, it often brings the possibility of heartache in love affairs, and short-term relationships rather than lasting ones. Desires and dreams could be limited.

If **14** is found as the *Life Path*, you must learn the lesson of detachment. This means to have and to let go. The law of change; gain and use freedom in the right way. There has been a tendency to cling to physical sensations. The things to learn in this lifetime are; to keep an open mind and do not miss any chance to learn. Do not overburden yourself with responsibilities and ties that will limit your movement and ability to learn about freedom. Opportunity and success for you come through new different things, people who are progressive. Be adaptable to change, new things, ideas, new places and people. Value your freedom, use it properly (no overuse or abuse) then you will truly be free and you will be able to allow others to have their freedom.

16/7 = Upheaval, unusual occurrences, difficult relationships.

The Tarot card number **16** is The *Tower* which depicts *ruin*. The falling tower indicates the

crushing of human pride and vanity, the structure was built of ignorance and wrong doing, through self-will and a self-centered life. Not until we understand the true nature of will power do we destroy false ideas, and learn what is right.

Number **16** warns of some strange calamity, defeat of plans, disgrace, accidents, deception, and adversity. It is a test of optimism and faith. It brings sudden, disruptive change into the life in order to awaken the soul to its path. This number encourages the person to be true to the authentic self - the whole self and its aspirations. Mysteries are revealed, and emotions are stirred at the deepest level. Intense lessons such as betrayal, abandonment, and loss of property are not unusual. Often the passage of this influence clears the way for increased attainment. Personal connections are often at a deep level.

If **16** is found as the *Soul Urge*, it shows false friends, misalliances and broken dreams. This is the tendency, which can be overcome in this lifetime. You must have true, unselfish love for others, faith and optimism. Always look for the good in all people and things, be optimistic about life and love. Build a good foundation of love and faith.

If **16** is found as the *Expression* number, it warns of loss of name, position, fortune, and power. There can be a problem with expressing faith or optimism. Do not be overly concerned with the *material* aspects of life. Work at building a solid foundation of faith and express it in all you do and say. You tend to be a secretive person and the inner knowledge possessed will help if the time is taken to quietly look for it.

If **16** is found as the *Personality* number, there is often a possibility that the desire for true love does not materialize. Until the value of love, and the realization that all things are temporary, there may be the suffering of a broken heart over and over again.

If **16** is found as the *Life Path* number, then all tragedies must be learned. You must not cling to the *material*. One thing that can keep the tower from falling is the power of discovering the inner self. In your lifetime you should learn to look at things carefully, see all there is to see in all circumstances (*power of the mind*). Take nothing at face-value; strive to know who you really are. You will find opportunities in serving others and expecting nothing in return. There is a lot to be learned by doing for others, the experience of dealing with people selflessly will help you gain strength and peace. Work with your inner guidance and knowledge.

19/1 = Identity, courage, independence.

The Number of *Saturn*. The 19 is the Collector of Taxes and demands Measure for Measure. Number 19 warns you not to be domineering, but exercise tolerance. This number is associated with painful past-life experiences in connection with leadership, self-esteem, courage or new ideas. When this number appears in a chart there is a tendency to either be too dominant and aggressive or weak-willed and fearful. There may be an inner drive to prove oneself or an ambition to be self-employed. However, subconscious fears may make a person too fearful to be visible. This is usually a political power in the broadest sense, ranging from power over a small group to power over millions. This number indicates a twisting of power for selfish reasons, to the harm of others. It is balanced by exposure of secrets, losses and wasted energy in this life.

If 19 is found as the *Soul Urge*, then you'll have to face all of life's secrets which may have been hidden and are now dragged out. It is the *harmonic* of *endurance*, to see how much you can stand. This can be overcome by learning to handle situations when they come up and avoid complaining. Instead of crying over spilled milk, do something about it. Pessimism can be left to others, work at being more of an optimist. Remember you are not the only person who has things go wrong in their life... everyone does... the biggest difference is how you handle them.

If 19 is found as the *Expression* number, take responsibility for all of your actions, If in a position of power, whether head of a business or head of a family, do not misuse it. Be thoughtful and compassionate of others.

If 19 is found as the *Personality* number, you may find yourself being used, and abused all in the name of love. Your dreams and desires are not likely to be fulfilled. Learn to release bitterness, and be more open about your feelings.

If 19 is found as the *Life Path*, then you must meet your failing and reap what you have sown, being bound when we want to be free. We must pay for bad past performance with time, money and ourselves. This number is the "*harmonic* of *endurance*". You should work on self-development. Learn to be self-reliant and independent; strengthen willpower, be creative take the initiative. By learning to depend upon yourself, you will be able to be responsible for your actions. Be a leader; make yourself indispensable in all areas of life. You can do it if you independently take responsibility for your actions.

The **Core Aspects**

The **Five (5) Numerology Core Numbers**

1. **Life Path** = Complete Birth Date
2. **Birth-day** = Day of the Month of Birth
3. **Expression Number or Destiny Number** = Full Name
4. **Heart's Desire or Soul's Urge** = Vowels in Full Name
5. **Personality** = Consonants in Full Name

There are **Five (5) Core Numbers** that make up a person's **Numerology** Chart. We will discuss each of these numbers in order and give their meanings and interpretations. A Numerology chart holds many aspects of who we are and what life holds in store for us. It shows **probabilities** and **possibilities**. Our physical existence is a manifestation of our individual **soul**. Within the manifestation of our soul, there is a desire to learn, grow, create and experience life itself. Each body has an individual pattern; a **soul harmonic**; that is unique unto itself. When we enter the physical world, each of us contains a seed. This seed has innate characteristics and instincts. These are the qualities that each individual pattern has brought with it. It also contains a purpose.

This seed which is planted at birth, has a great intention within it. The expression of this life is a evolutionary spiral. You will have experiences of expansion, connection, and awareness; if it is of divine nature sustain this evolutionary process. There is great reliance on innate knowledge to assist in growth, and the greatest hearts desires, to fuel it as it moves towards its purpose. As roots grow, there is maturing by the knowing of its place in co-creation.

Numerology gives us a tool to interpret the physical manifestation of our individual **harmonics**. By applying this tool we can gain an understanding of our unique pattern. Within each of us there are **five** distinct aspects which wish to be synthesized and brought into balance. These are considered the **Core Aspects** of a chart. There are many modifiers to these aspects which we will also cover as we progress.

Often people find that their **Name Harmonics** doesn't ring a bell' with them, especially their **Expression** Number. However, with an understanding of the **harmonics** they find that this number does in fact "Grow on them." Remember that often the hardest chart to delineate is your own. It is much easier to be objective with someone else.

It might be helpful to think of the numbers as representing a multitude of voices within yourself. Often you will find that certain numbers do not complement others, and as some of you found you relate to the *Life Path* number but perhaps do not so much to the *name* harmonics.

Remember there are many influences throughout our lives which shape our lives; this is why we never should do a reading on one single number; the whole chart needs to be looked at to really see an accurate picture. Many people find that a number prominent in their charts is foreign to what they see themselves as. Perhaps you have a *Seven Expression*, but you are not on a spiritual path at all, or really are not very introspective. Maybe you are still quite young, and have still not had opportunity to develop this side of yourself. Perhaps you are on a spiritual path but your major numbers do not indicate this, however the whole chart may show this very clearly. Or, perhaps another number in your chart has been influencing you up to this time, which has been promoting alternate experiences.

We often develop familiarity, even a great liking for certain parts of ourselves as we recognize them. Then suddenly an unusual or stressful occurrence will bring out other parts of ourselves, which just may surprise us. This is why it is so necessary to consider the whole chart before making any judgments of the person we are looking at or even ourselves.

Life Path:

This aspect is found from the *date of birth*. It represents our journey throughout life. It shows what we are really like. The qualities it contains want to be utilized and acknowledged. It holds the innate natural abilities we have. It is the *harmonic* the *soul*. The *Life Path* harmonics are with us our whole life; it cannot be changed. By embracing the resources we have been given in our *Life Path*, we are able to synthesize our other core aspects.

The *Life Path* is also called the *Birth Force*, *Birth Path*, *Destiny* and probably some others. Regardless of what it is called by different people, it is always the sum of your *date of birth*. Often considered the most *important number* in Numerology, it shows your natural abilities, talents, lessons you have chosen to learn and opportunities you will encounter along the way. It represents the *potentials*, *possibilities* and *probabilities* you have chosen to work with and manifest here on Earth during this lifetime.

Often mis-called the '*Destiny Number*', it does not tell what the destiny of the person will be. It is up to you to decide what you want to do with your life, and the options are limitless. This number however shows the path, which will lead you to the destination of your choice. The *Life Path* represents the cyclical *harmonic* energy in which you emerged with on your date of birth. This is one aspect, which cannot be changed, even if you at times wish you had another perhaps easier or different type of path to follow. The energy of this number stays with you throughout your lifetime. It is the energy you will carry no matter what other influences you find during your life cycles. When your *Life Path* number is accepted and properly understood, and then it's challenges are faced and overcome it becomes your greatest strength.

With "*Free Will*" you have been given the freedom to do with your life as you please: to fulfill its potential completely, or to make some smaller version of yourself. The potential is there within you. You make the decision to fulfill, to whatever extent, the potential of life that exists within you. It is your choice.

Another interesting point of the *Life Path* is many people seem to instantly relate to it. They may be a bit 'iffy' about their name *harmonics*, but the *Life Path* seems to strike a chord in most.

Numerology uses the *Digital Root* system of addition, which is just a fancy name for adding numbers together to derive the lowest single integer. At this stage we reduce all numbers to a number between 1 and 9 except if we have a Master Number of 11, 22 or 33. You will also see compound numbers used in more advanced Numerology, however for basic chart reading we will only consider the *Digital Root* numbers.

The *Life Path* is derived from your complete *date of birth*. Although there are different methods of working out the *Life Path*, for simplicity I am going to continue the use of the beginning date in this manuscript because it encompasses the *mystic* number *seven* and also shows reasons why the complete chart should be analyzed instead of centering on certain parts. Date of birth: The beginning *November 7th, 2013* birth date. Will be used

$$\text{Birth-Month} = \text{November} = 11$$

$$\text{Birth-Day} = 07$$

$$\text{Birth-Year} = 2013 = (2+0+1+3) = 6$$

Successively Sum the Compound Numbers listed above

$$\text{Life Path Number Summation} = (11+07+6) = (24) = (2+4) = 6$$

As can be seen above, the combination of all *three* values taken at once gives a *Life Path value* of

Six (6). It is common practice to include a **zero (0)** on all persons who have a **single** birthday number like **7 = 07** which enhances the **correctness** of its value.

This particular method of calculation is what I use and by no means the 'only' or correct method for everyone. All methods will arrive at the same 'base number' however there will at times be variations in **Master Numbers**. Try out various methods and find which works for you. (However be careful not to manipulate the numbers to arrive at a **Master Number**, in other words 'stick with one particular method'). When I come across a **Master Number** in the Life Path I calculate it by a couple of different methods to see how consistent the **Master Number** is. This multi calculation is especially helpful in the case of **33/6** which is a very evolved harmonic and quite difficult to live up to. When **Master Numbers** are found in the **Life Path** it is very important to consider the whole chart.

No matter how we calculate this date it reduces to **Six (6)**. The **Life Path** is where you need to be extra careful not to 'manipulate' the method to derive at a **Master Number**, of course the **Life Path** is just one number in the chart and other numbers will need to be taken into account. At this stage I think it is important just to get a good grasp of the base numbers (**1-9**).

Once you have completed the calculations of the **Life Path**, immediately show its interpretation

Life Path Six (6) **Number Six Harmonic**



Service, Domestic, Responsible, Careful, Teacher, Conventional, Provider, Healer.

The **number 6** is unique because it is related to the nurturing and loving qualities of a person. People with the **number 6** are very protective of their inner circle and are constantly ready to function as a tower of strength. The **number six** person lives to help others.

The **number Six** symbolizes the principle of nurturing, caring, and harmony. It signifies the need for stability and a solid home base with comfort. It is the **teacher, trainer** and **parent**. It is happiest in conventional or familiar surroundings, and its **negative** qualities include, **opinionated, frugal**, or **anxious** when insecure. **Six** is rarely selfish and may take on the burdens of others unnecessarily. It loves tradition, and is health oriented.

Six's keywords just seem to glow all over them. *Emotional, Sensitive, Family Responsibilities* and *Compassion*. **Six** is the "*Mother*" of all numbers; it links families and keeps people together. A number **Six** is *trustworthy, sympathetic, gentle, and loving*.

Six has a need to teach us that we are stronger *united* than we would be alone. Caring for family, both personal and universal, is the only way that they will stay safe. **Six** is a natural healer and quick to get into service-oriented professions. **Six** is very intuitive about what people are all about inside, and a natural empathizer.

Six's are *reliable, hard-working, responsible, and trustworthy*. They are excellent "troubleshooters," they foresee problems and foster cooperation, but they can also become *defensive, evasive, and anxious*—running on *stress* while rarely complaining about it. They can be cautious and indecisive, but also *reactive, defiant and rebellious*.

Problems crop up for **Six** when it does too much for others and forgets about its own needs. Emotional bonds to others is life sustaining; total dependence on others is *life draining*. **Six** is here to teach us all how to care for each other. **Six** also has to learn how to let go and let others care for themselves at times.

If you have a *Life Path Number 6*, one of your main objectives is to care for others in need — and it's important that you are able to strike harmony in all areas of life. You are recognized for your altruism and ability to connect with others in a meaningful way.

This number is often called a "*Universal or Cosmic Parent*" (because of the aspects of Universal love, compassion, sympathy and peace) and is a born adviser, idealist, conscientious, poised, devoted, and dedicated to home and family life. The **Six** is *honorable* in service, and *responsible* towards others. They are good listeners and problem solvers and have a natural ability to find practical solutions to the challenges faced by those around them. In relationships, *Life Path Number 6* individuals are known for their selflessness and their ability to provide emotional support to their friends, family, and partners.

Six is also the first *perfect* number which means the *sum* and *product* of its factors (1, 2 and 3) are equal to the number itself i.e., $(1 + 2 + 3 = 6)$ and $(1 \times 2 \times 3 = 6)$.

Life Path Interpretations

These are Keyword type interpretations waiting for your own special semantic touch

Number One

Path of independence. Tools are determination and ambition; is self-confident, ambitious, and wants to be in charge; be your own person but without stepping on others. Leadership qualities. An independent person who can stand on their own *two* feet, but, also able to take charge of others. A very pleasant path based on self-expression and enjoyable activities in a harmonious atmosphere. When undertaking a project you are more interested in the product of your efforts than material gains.

Needs to learn concentration and patience, has a tendency to get scattered and fail to finish what is started. Jealousy can be a problem and must be kept in check. Seeks beauty, love and a free sexual life, the problems encountered are only slight and not difficult to overcome. It is considered the most pleasant path by many Numerologists.

Number Four

Path of organization; tools are justice and determination. It gives us useful results from labor. It helps us satisfy our need for productivity and excellence in our work. It can be a hard path because it predicts a life of hard work; however if you love the work you are doing, it won't seem like a hard path at all. To be trustworthy, organized and foster an inborn ability for inborn work. Life can seem limited but this doesn't mean unhappiness. In fact, most on the **Four** path enjoy happy homes and solid careers, building for mankind, brick by brick. Can find it difficult to accept new things or innovation and find it difficult to relate to the "free souls" you may encounter on the way. Being stubborn and holding grudges will only weigh you down. The keyword here is application.

Number Five

Path of freedom: tools are wit, enthusiasm, and energy. The world would be a dull place without **5's**. Somehow you keep things moving, clever and enthusiastic, you do not allow things to remain the same around you. If not physically moving (residence) you are rearranging furniture, closets, cupboards. One of the attributes of business success is the fact that you add pep and speed to whatever you undertake. The weak points to watch out for and try to overcome are being a rolling stone, which gathers no moss, by allowing your love of freedom and change to grow so strong

that you become discontented easily. Be careful of being too analytical, unsympathetic and enjoying stirring things up. It is a varied path, being marked with change, freedom, variety, adventure and curiosity. Hanging onto a person or situation will make this path difficult. Number Six

You need the same love and sympathy you give to others returned by them for best growth. The keyword is responsibility.

Number Seven

Path of specialization; tools are facts followed by spirituality. The path of the thinker, philosopher and dreamer. More of loner than most people, and really not concerned with material things, more concerned with enlightenment and knowledge. Wants a peaceful life, and tends not to be the greatest spouse because tends to be distant and aloof, even with their mate. Math, science, medicine and research attract these people as does the ministry, rabbinate or priesthood, as part of the seeking of enlightenment on all levels. Watch for a tendency to be too withdrawn and silent. Usually adaptable but at times may find it hard. Often can be a doubter, and come across hard and cold. Other people often find this person hard to understand, and sometimes the **Seven** finds it hard to understand themselves. Tends to be stoic as too much emotion strips ability to think clearly. The keyword here is *perfection*.

Number Eight

Path of management; tools are efficiency, authority, and courage. This is the path of power, authority and material success. Generous, dependable and courageous, but needs to control your

love for power and money. Essential to develop moral business ethics and learn to understand those people who are less forceful than you. You tend not to get mad; you get even, when in fact you should get over it and let it go. You can be very successful on a material level or constantly broke or even both on this path. It depends on how you live this path. Those on this path have the courage and energy to try and try again until they reach their goal. Remember the law of giving and receiving. Be careful not to step on others in order to reach your goal. Learn to use the money you have gained wisely. Beware if your only thought is self-gain. The keywords here are material aspects.

Number Nine

Path of the seeker; reaching for life's mysteries; be tolerant. This is the path of compassion, sympathy, tolerance, and a wide range of feelings for mankind. A path of understanding, knowledge, intuition and willingness to sacrifice. Tends to be a perfectionist are sometimes disappointed in others because they do not measure up to the standard of perfection set for self, and then look for in them. harmonic to an individual. By working on the *Digital Root Six* much more will be gained by following the strong points of the number *Six harmonic*.

Lessons of the Life Paths

One: Sharing, co-operation, compromise, arbitration and support.

Two: Sharing, co-operation, compromise, arbitration and support.

Three: Avoid scattering talents, wasting time; bring joy through feelings.

Four: Become less limited in your ways. Learn service to others.

Five: To learn to use constructive use of Freedom and not waste abilities by getting lost in solely physical desires.

Six: To learn to give the beauty of love and harmony, sympathy and understanding, protection and balance. Along with balance, the lesson of responsibly can be meaningful. You may find yourself responsible for more than what seems your share. Understanding friendship, harmony and love through your own experience is an important lesson here.

Seven: Introspection so that you will be able to analyze what you have learned, so that you possess much knowledge and understanding. Must learn to be alone but not feel lonely. Investigation, Specialist, Inventor, Loner, Eccentric, Thoughtful, Spiritual, Reclusive, Intellectual, the Mystic, the Prophet.

People with a **Birth-Day Number seven** are believed to be insightful, intuitive, truthful, introspective, intellectual, and wise. **seven's** are super smart, curious, and eager to create resolutions to worldly problems. They will use any form of knowledge or insight to reach their goals. There is a driving force within all **seven's** to seek knowledge, truth, and insight. The number **Seven** symbolizes humanity's deep inner need to find depth, meaning, and a mental connection. When someone's needs of food, self-expression, material and domestic achievements have been met, we turn to the deeper levels of life - to learn, to educate ourselves, and to find purpose. 1st Day of the Month

5 Birthdays

5th Day of the Month

Indicates that you are adaptable, enthusiastic and somewhat boastful. You have a fine mind and active imagination, and love to serve up your stories with all the trimmings. A lover of life, you're excellent company and keep things *moving rapidly*. Yours is a life filled with all sorts of new experiences and constant change. Although you are the type who refuses to be tied down by anything, you are the "*marrying kind*". You have a good singing and speaking voice.

14th Day of the Month

Indicates a versatile and dual person with both a *reasoning* and *prophetic* mind. "Lucky" in games of chance and contests, you're a natural better and gambler. Your success lies in business on a large scale, but you need some form of artistic expression for recreation and to "*let off steam*". Very emotional, you can always be appealed to through your feelings and sympathies. You are apt to crave constant change, and should avoid all of the pitfalls associated with the physical - drugs, alcohol, promiscuity and other sexual excess. You can be a *bridge* between the *physical* and *spiritual* worlds, and have great constructive or destructive power - as you choose.

23rd Day of the Month

Indicates a sympathetic, sensitive, understanding person with a practical turn of mind. You have an uncanny ability to diagnose physical ailments and would therefore be well suited for a career in medicine (but not surgery, since the mission of this *harmonic* is to build and heal instead of tear down and destroy). Your technical ability and practicality may give you an interest in law, chemistry or stocks, but you are simply too practical to succeed in art. Self-sufficient, popular and sociable, you do not suffer from an inferiority complex. You get a lot out of life because you make the best of any situation. You're a good friend who is willing to take on many responsibilities.

6 Birthdays

6th Day of the Month

Indicates a *love nature*. You bloom with praise and appreciation, but wilt in the face of criticism. When involved in a relationship you lavish your affection on your beloved - at least for as long as

the relationship lasts. The **six** seeks *perfection* and *seldom* finds it, so it looks elsewhere. Following such a course will earn you a reputation for being untrustworthy. You love children but don't have to have your own to be happy. Even though you are well protected, you worry constantly about not having enough money. *Mental* rather than *intellectual*, you have natural acting abilities that can help you succeed on the stage or in business. You have literary and artistic tendencies, and can attract the money or backing you need. The one in which you are *not* talented is *mechanics*. Having people around you in a harmonious atmosphere is essential to your well being.

15th Day of the Month

Indicates a gifted person under the protection of the kindly, harmonious **six** who absorbs knowledge rather than acquires it through hard study. In fact, you attract many things - friends, gifts, money, opportunities, and give the impression of youthfulness and good health. You're capable of much self-sacrifice for a good cause or to help a friend, but you will not submit to domination. 24th Day of the Month

7 Birthdays

7th Day of the Month

Indicates a *specialist*, one with a *keen mind* capable of *deep* mental analysis. Strongly *intuitive* if not *psychic*, you should never take advice that goes against your "*gut feelings*". You have talent for stringed instruments (including the piano) and the organ, as well as excellent judgment in money matters. 16th Day of the Month

Indicates a nervous and sometimes irritable person who makes complications and intricacies and then suffers the consequences. Naturally aloof, you nonetheless lean toward home and affection. Though you can succeed in art or literature, your powers of reason and analysis demand a business outlet as well. While not actively aggressive, you don't like your plans interfered with. You tend to put off until the things you know you that you should be doing right now, and live too much within yourself. As much as you want *affection*, you don't always make the *effort* to earn it.

25th Day of the Month

Indicates a naturally prophetic and *intuitive* person with a strong leaning toward the *occult*. You tend to conceal your true feelings and as a result are not always understood. Artistically gifted, you can commercialize almost any area of art to which you are inclined. Success can also be enjoyed in the professions, business or the constructive side of politics. You tend to be vacillating and inconsistent, and until you overcome this tendency your affairs will suffer. It's imperative that you learn to concentrate, force your mind into stability and away from a sense of inferiority, self-pity and depression. Your *affections* are your greatest *weakness*, and you must always stay on the straight and narrow, for there's a strong tendency to wander from the path that inclines you to preach morals but practice excess. 8 Birthdays

8th Day of the Month

Indicates a creative, productive individual with natural *business acumen*. Progressive and expansive, you deal well in matters of general or public interests, but should avoid equal

partnerships because you need to be in a position to make the *final* decisions. Large businesses, corporations or government are your particular area of interest, in any of which you must express *honesty* and *integrity* in order to be permanently successful. Fonder of books than you are of reading, you're inclined toward large gestures, if you have it, you give great sums of money to institutions or charities. You are somewhat inclined to impress others and want your family to be a credit to you.

17th Day of the Month

Indicates a high minded, proud spirited individual, sometimes liberal, sometimes conservative, generous or stingy, collecting or dissipating. Very set in your ideas, you seldom yield to others, in business you do best at the head of the enterprise, working with under-partners. You execute whatever you do, have a particular talent for managing the interests and affairs of others, and are drawn to dealing in large affairs. The details are for someone else to take care of, since you hate being bothered with them. You can be successful in any enterprise connected with the *earth* (e.g.: land, mining, oil, livestock), as well as writing, though you are more inclined to technical or historical writing than to fiction. You love knowledge and like to explore. When it comes to *spiritual* matters, you want *proof*.

26th Day of the Month

Indicates an individual with full closets and drawers, for nothing is too small for practical use, and you just know that you'll need it if you get rid of it. You're very introspective and tend to live in the past - to the detriment of the present and future. Although you *start* many things, you find it hard to *finish* them, and either rise above or falls below average - as you choose. You can commercialize anything in the artistic lines - except music - in a big way. You can also do well in politics or diplomacy, and should have a good education. You have a beautiful domestic nature, love home and children and are the "*marrying kind*". Fastidious about you personal belongings and fond of color and show it in the clothes you wear, you nonetheless do not insist on physical comforts and are very generous to others.

9 Birthdays

9th Day of the Month

Indicates publicity, distribution, art, broadmindedness and philanthropy (defined in The Wizard of Oz as "good deed doing"). You're interested in *metaphysics* and relate them to what's going on in

the *world*. Literary, artistic and strong willed, you're a *natural ruler* who can succeed in almost anything artistic, as well as writing, teaching, law, publishing or the ministry. You need a broad education so that you can better choose your profession. You belong both *in* and *to* the world, making it *difficult* for you to lead a purely *personal* life successfully. Marriage during the middle portion of your life is likely to end, through death, divorce or some other separation, though the love may remain intact. Yours is a life filled with long journeys and many changes.

18th Day of the Month

Indicates a person whose life is filled with *change*, *activity*, and *travel*. You may find yourself responsible for the care of groups or communities that will tap your fund of helpfulness. Much is expected of you because much has been given to you: The independence of the **1** and the efficiency of the **8**, manifesting to mankind through the **9**. Since you don't like to take advice, it's as well that you rarely need it. You're drawn to any large field in need of efficient administration ie law, politics, religion, and although your first efforts may not always succeed, you do succeed on repetition - so try, try again. Somewhat emotional, you are nonetheless intellectual and enjoy both *reasoning* and *arguing*. These traits equip you well as a drama critic, writer or speaker. In money matters you are never rash, for you feel the responsibility of handling material assets. Marriages or engagements made during the middle portion of your life are likely to be broken.

27th Day of the Month

Indicates more materially inclined individual than those born on other "9" birthdays (**9th** and **18th**). The **27** is a strong marriage harmonic, though the experience may be disappointing. You're forceful, quietly determined but somewhat erratic, a natural leader who cannot be satisfied in a subordinate position. Neither do you like to account for your own conduct. Versatile and artistic, you also have literary talents and could be a journalist, writer, lecturer, or teacher. You're ardent in your affections but tend to overdo family traits. Your religious tendencies are toward Eastern beliefs and away from orthodoxy.

Expression:

The *name* given to us at birth is what we must be in this life. It is a promise of *opportunity*. When we embrace the qualities of this harmonic, we find added experiences, knowledge and growth. This *harmonic* helps us find evidence of our purpose. As we synthesize this *core* aspect of

ourselves, we often discover a deeper connection to our other parts. Sometimes there are *natural abilities* found within the *Expression* number.

The *Expression* is sometimes (*often*) called the *Destiny Number*.

A few have asked what names we actually use when working out a chart and what effect do name changes and nick-names have on our life. What name should you use -- your current name, married name, original name or nickname?

ALWAYS use the *full, original name* as it appears on the *birth certificate*. Do not use *nicknames*, *married* names or *any other* name change such as *adoption* or *legal* name changes until you have *learned* all you can from the *original name*.

If you were adopted, and your name was changed legally even at one or *two* weeks of age and you have used the new name all your life, you still *initially* do a chart with your *original name*. Even if you have never used that name! Then work up another small chart with the name change. Often people who have been adopted very early do harmonize much more to the name change.

Your original *birth name* defines a *blueprint* of you and your life. It is believed by many Numerologists that we actually choose our own name which best represents our gifts, lessons and challenges by a psychic connection between our parents and us. It is the real *YOU*.

A change of name, whether married name, nicknames, assumed name or the name you use now, as in a signature can be calculated for comparison to the original name. Any name change does *not negate* the *original* name. It merely adds *extra harmonics* and therefore other lessons, gifts and challenges to your life. This can be beneficial or not so beneficial. It is always preferable to analyze a name before deliberately changing it.

Have you ever commented "Wow she has changed since she was married!" Sure, it's because she has changed her name. This change is gradual, usually in force around *12* months after the change.

Harmonics of the Name

Every *letter* of the *alphabet* has a *harmonic* associated with one of the numbers *1 - 9*.

Write out your *Full Name* and assign each letter a number using the *Digital Root* chart above, *Note Y and W are sometimes considered vowels. See *last* topic. Then put all the numbers under their letters and *sum* them.

When you add these numbers it is worth checking them at least once to make sure you have put the correct values under the letters and that you have added them up correctly. Many Numerologists have had to do a chart several times because of an incorrect number or addition. This goes for all the calculations we do along the way. Sometimes an aspect will seem quite wrong to you and you will find the additions were wrong not the system. This is why I prefer to add the whole name numbers separately rather than putting vowels on top and consonants on bottom which is the most common way. However with the *Soul's Urge* and *Personality* together, if they do not add to the *Digital Root* of the *Expression* number as then you know you have made an error in addition or missed a number this way.

In your *Digital Root* additions, if you come up with a *Master Number* then it becomes the *Expression* or *Destiny Number*. The chart below is Sage's *Expression* or *Destiny Number* calculations and interpretations.

9th Harmonic

Universal, Generalist, Multi-Talented, Teacher; Humanitarian, Healer, Artist, and an Old-Soul,

Nine is believed to represent *completeness, balance, and perfection*. According to Indian numerology, the number **nine** is associated with qualities such as courage, leadership, and determination. Number **nine** represents the ruling planet **Mars** and people with **Destiny Numbers 9, 18th, and 27th** of any month possess its qualities of *ambition, confidence, stamina, and energy*. They are down-to-earth and disciplined, but can also be *aggressive, stubborn, and speak harshly*.

The **number 9** is also significant number in other philosophies; it is believed to represent *completion, attainment, and fulfillment*. People who have a **Destiny Number 9** are said to be *compassionate, generous, and selfless*. They are also believed to have a strong spiritual connection and are often drawn to helping others.

Nine remembers that we have been taught if our brother or sister needs our shirt, we give them our coat as well. **Nine** takes us a step beyond the material planes or even the mental plane of thoughts and ideas. It gently guides us toward the realization that we are not only with each other, but also part of the *Fundamental 1st Harmonic* that creates our higher *harmonics*.

Nine is the number of *endings*, no one usually likes endings, but of course each ending brings forth a new beginning, something to look forward to. Without endings some things just wouldn't happen. **Nine** is also a number of the *healer* and deals with the math properties of **number 9**.

Nine is recursive. Add **9** to any number. ($9 + 7 = 16$). Then add the resulting two numbers together ($1 + 6 = 7$). Now add **9** again to the result. It is recursively the same number as we began with.

When **Nine** enters there is a change in *substance*. **Nine** involves us in "*actions*" which take us "*across*" and "*beyond*" the *inner "substance"* of what we were before, yet leaves us gently unchanged. We are the same; but we are on a more active level of *harmonics*.

The individuals with **Destiny Number 9** are quite unique. They are compassionate, self-aware and always looking for resolution. Being highly evolved, the **number 9's** powerful harmonics energizes them well to be successful leaders, and helpful in their humanitarian causes. You're holistic **Destiny** is to be *idealistic* and *passionate*, dedicating to making the world around you a better place.

As the final **core number**, the number **nine** holds special rank. It is associated with *forgiveness*, *compassion*, and *success* on the *positive* side as well as *arrogance* and *self-righteousness* on the *negative* side. **Nine** is the *Humanitarian* number.

Number One:

Here to be a leader; can meet obstacles with courage and will rise; *creative* and *independent*; a non-conformist. A tower of strength. Has his own ideas and will not be swayed by the opinions of others. Needs to be his own boss, and enjoys being *alone* at times. Tends to be *creative*, *inventive* and *original*. Good occupations would be acting, own business, head of department, supervisor.

Has fixity of purpose and unswerving drive toward achievement in their own particular interest or line of work. Single minded or one-track-mindedness. Must develop the ability to be a fine leader, sales *executive*, or *promoter*. Has the gifts to become an original person with a creative approach to problems solving, and a great skill for initiating action. Perhaps someone will have to follow behind though to handle the details but you have the tools of powerful *character*, *positive*, *self-reliant* and *self-assertive*, *aggressive* and *ambitious*. Has fantastic powers of *concentration* and very *good memory*.

Lead, create, originate and invent. Pioneers, who are always drawn to the new and unusual. Very *independent*, do not like to take orders from others well, and tend not to operate with ease.

Although may listen to the advice of others, very rarely will take it, and often resents the intrusion.

Although fears loneliness, often wants to be left *alone*. Fears routine and being in a rut. Usually has only a few close friends rather than many superficial friends. Often if friendly and sympathetic, it may be because it is advantageous to be so. Tends to dominate others, sometimes to the point of tyranny.

This does not mean total ease with everyone whom you come in contact with. This is because we are not totally compatible with each harmonic we touch. Has a healthy respect for individuality and no longer needs to be angry or judgmental about another person

One's can have a strong intuitive gift. Often they are able to "*smell*" the solution to a problem. But often they won't admit intuition had anything to do with it. They prefer to believe that it was hard work and thinking it through.

The *negative One* can be *egotistic* and *self-centered* in their approach to life. This is an aggressive number and if it is over-emphasized can be hard to live with. Remember you do not have to be overly aggressive to fulfill your destiny. You do not have to dominate and destroy in order to have creative talents in any of the arts, though these might be latent. Very optimistic and ever enthusiastic about life and living. Friendly, loving and social, and well liked by others because of charm and good conversation. The ability to communicate often inspired others. The role in life here is to *inspire* and *motivate*; to raise the spirits of those around you.

Number Two:

Has an innate sense of rhythm is suited to music or poetry. Be aware that sensitive emotional nature can cause abuse by self-centered people. Guard against co-dependence. **Two** is very patient, and has an analytical mind. Attention

to detail, but don't get caught up in pettiness over matters that are not important. Would do very well as a bookkeeper, teacher, librarian, and record keeper.

These people have the qualities, which are traditionally regarded as *beta*. They are quiet, tactful, and conciliatory. Even tempered, lovers of peace and harmony. Tend to play second fiddle and make excellent subordinates. They are conscientious, tidy and modest. Followers rather than leaders, and if they get their own way it is because they do it by persuasion and diplomacy, not by assertion. Can be quite detail oriented.

Often they are *shy* and *self-conscious*. They are likely to change their minds often, and tend to put things off, and generally procrastinate.

Number **Four**

Because you are responsible and loyal you stand by your family, friends and country through all situations. Viewpoint is conservative, is at best in fields that require *accuracy, concentration* and *perseverance*. Tends to be conservative, neat and detailed, and often self-conscious. Being fairly quiet talks softly and is not prone to showing off.

Being very *practical* and *serious*, you may be hard on *yourself*. Be aware that being so practical can make your life a little boring, especially if you give in to a tightwad tendency. Over-caution can put you into a rut, and if you have a stubborn streak try to loosen it a bit. Examples of occupations you do well in are *construction*, *engineering*, *accounting*, *manufacturing* or almost anything *material* related. Or in a position that require accuracy such as an inspector, *technician*, *proofreader*, *accountant*.

Those who incarnate for this experience should bear in mind that the human body - in common with a well-maintained machine - must rest from time to time, as a workaholic tendency may prevail. Very conventional in outlook these individuals are not the types to make rash decisions but will seek to use their powerful will when faced with opposition. They should seek careers, which allow them to freely express their practical nature and are best suited to trades/professions, which demand concentration and accuracy.

There is a strong motivation towards order, service, and management. These people have a very down-to-earth approach to life. Very kind and ever willing to work long hours to push a project through to completion. Patience with detail allow you to become an expert in the fields such as building, engineering, and all forms of craftsmanship. Any abilities towards writing and teaching will be in a technical and detailed manner.

Material security is very important to these people and there may be a tendency to hoard all manner of rubbish and to be rather miserly. However, money in common with all forms of energy must be allowed to flow freely if long-term benefits are to accrue - a suggestion likely to be ignored by most *'Fours'*.

In the *negative* there may be times where the obligations you face may create frustration and feelings of limitation and restriction. This can cause a bit of a low mood. Avoid becoming too *rigid*, *stubborn*, *dogmatic*, and *fixed* in your opinions. Very strong likes and dislikes may border on prejudice. Watch for tendency to become bossy and dominant and use a disciplinarian attitude to excess. Try not to get wrapped up in detail and routine.

Number Five

Not only can you cope with *constant change* and the *unexpected*, you *thrive* on it. Your fearlessness doesn't allow you to acknowledge the existence of *hazards*. Enjoying life's pleasures

is just your forte, so it's not surprising that your sensual responses are well developed. You have great sex appeal. You easily make friends with strangers and are attracted to occupations that bring new experiences and contact with people. Publicity, sales, advertising and journalism are examples of the type of occupations you are suited for. You appear to have a *friendly nature*, but can be prone to mood swings with the snap of a finger. You have enough charm to sell an Eskimo ice. You hate being taken for granted; and most often cannot be second guessed. You can be sporadic, overdoing it with sexual and sensual pleasures too can cause problems.

These *harmonics* endows the individual with the wonderful characteristics of multi-talents and versatility. Can do so many things well. The tone of the *number 5* is constructive freedom, and in your drive to attain this freedom, you will likely to be the master of adaptability and change. Very *clever, analytical*, and a very *quick thinker*.

These individuals possess great communication skills. Never at a loss for words, they have silver tongues and a quick repartee evoking hails of laughter (or *shouts of rage* when the response is *unkind*). Quick witted and mercurial by nature they live for the moment rather than a nebulous tomorrow. They should avoid indulging in petty gossip or empty boasting for both will be to their detriment.

Good at presenting ideas and this makes you ideal for selling, and spells success when working with people in most jobs.

If the harmonics are expressed in a negative sense, there may be restlessness and impatience that may prevent following through a project or task. Can be rather erratic and scattered. There can be difficulty in keeping regular office hours and maintaining any sort of routine. Can react strongly if you feel that your freedom of speech or action is being impaired or restricted in any way. As clever as you are, you may tend to make the same mistakes over and over, as your response is a glib reaction rather than of thoughtful application. Can be in a constant state of flux brought on by constantly changing interests.

Number Six:

An innate sense of fairness allows this person to size up situations *quickly* and *accurately*, and has the ability to calm down even the most *stressed* situations. But at the same time will not back down from a fight if a principle you believe in is involved. A strong sense of responsibility means

honesty and reliability when dealing with others. As long as this person's emotions are not involved they make an extremely good counselor because a fair viewpoint helps others see their problems more clearly. These people have a flair for *color*, *texture* and *form*, especially in things that are decorative and useful. Jobs that suit these people are ones that involve serving others such as social work, medicine, or government service, and they make *extremely good parents*. They need to be aware of becoming a meddling busybody as a side effect of trying to right everyone's wrongs. Self-righteousness can make it difficult to adjust to people with differing opinions.

These *harmonics* provide a truly outstanding sense of responsibility, *love* and *balance*. Helpful and ever conscientious, makes this individual quite capable of rectifying and balancing any sort of inharmonious situation. They are very inclined to give help and comfort to anyone in need. A natural penchant for working with the old, the young, the sick or the underprivileged. Although there often is a considerable creative and artistic talent, the chances are that this person will devote themselves to an occupation that shows concern for the betterment of the community.

Very *loving*, *caring* and *appreciative* of others. Has a depth of understanding that produces much sympathetic, *kindness*, and *generosity*. Make wonderful parents, and deeply involved in family and domestic activities. *Openness* and *honesty* is apparent in all relationships.

A caring nature and a desire to be loved will be very evident within these people and the latter could well mar their life with much time spent in the search of a loving relationship. There will also have a strong desire for justice and fair play. As they may be stifled in certain environments, they should ensure that their chosen career will permit them a measure of freedom of thought and expression.

Management levels within government services, particularly those dealing with international aid programs or education would prove stimulating, as would the medical field or social welfare. In such a workaday environment they will be given many opportunities to love without expectation of return - their major challenge in life.

On the negative side there may be a tendency to be too exacting and demanding of self. May sacrifice yourself (or loved ones) for the welfare of others. If too overzealous may have trouble

distinguishing between helping and interfering. Too much involvement in causes and responsibilities may bring a difficulty in expressing own individuality. May worry too much.

Number Seven:

Appears to be living in a world of their own sometimes, takes everything in your stride and does not ruffle easily. The things you speak about you are well versed in, and have little time for those who talk about things they know little about. *Sensitive, emotional* and kind of *secretive*. Very imaginative and mental at the same time, you can excel in physical sciences and go beyond them to deeper truths where *intuition* guides your knowledge. Abilities in *abstract thought* allow development philosophies that work for not only one but all of mankind. However your nature may make it difficult for you to communicate these ideas particularity to those less intelligent than you. Works best *alone* and when allowed to use superior thinking ability. Occupations that suit your quiet nature are writer, auditor, librarian, astronomer, investigation, psychology, or technical writing. Watch out for *mood swings* and *depression*, a by product of being a *loner*. The only thing you must fear is fear itself, because if it takes hold it can destroy you.

Characteristics of this *harmonic* are *thought, analysis, introspection*, and *seclusiveness*. The hallmark of this person is a good mind, and especially good at searching out and finding the truth. Capable of *analyzing, judging* and *discriminating*, and very little ever escapes your observation and deep understanding. The type of person who can really get involved in a search for wisdom or hidden truth, often becoming an *authority* on whatever you are focusing on. This can be of a technical or scientific nature, or it may be religious or occult, it matters very little, all knowledge is pursued with the same sort of vigor.

Can make a very fine teacher, or because of a natural inclination toward the spiritual, you may become deeply emerged in religious affairs or even *psychic* explorations.

Many who experience this *harmonic* lead unhappy lives for they are little understood by those around and about them, a fact not always aided by an aloof manner. Possessed of a deeply sensitive nature, their natural inclination is to *retreat* from *life*, being uncomfortable when surrounded by large numbers of people. Tends to operate in a rather different *wavelength*, and many friends may not really know you very well.

A true perfectionist in a very positive sense of the word. Very *logical*, and usually employs a quite *rational* approach to most things. An excellent capacity to study.

Gifted individuals, blessed with the ability to communicate with Higher Minds and Planes of Consciousness. Some of them have the capacity to readily identify the talents possessed by others. Thus encouraging them to fulfill their true purpose in life. This skill is best channeled into the role of Spiritual Counselor, whereby they may utilize their *sixth* and *seventh* senses to the highest degree.

If these undertakings fill them with apprehension or fear they should perhaps develop the analytical aspect of their nature and seek a career within the field of psychology or psychiatry. As '*Seven*' individuals also have a deep affinity with the world of nature, market gardening, rare plant cultivation or landscaping could well be suitable.

In the *negative* there may be a limited degree of trust in other people. A tendency to be highly *introverted* can make for a self-centered person, and certainly very much self-contained. This can make for someone who is not very *adaptable*, and may tend to be overly *critical* and *intolerant*. Prefers to work *alone* and at their own pace and in own way. Neither shows or understands emotions very well.

Number Eight:

Strong, *authoritative*, and often *dominant* personality. This person dresses well, in clothes that look expensive, and they usually are if you can at all manage it. Enjoys the good things in life, and usually knows how to get them. Likes *group activities*. Potential lies in business and finance, as they are *natural*, *efficient*, *organized* executives geared towards *achievement*. Knows how to make efforts pay, has sound judgment and is fair when dealing with people. As well as business these people do well in sports. Does well as a financial advisers, business analyst, public official, head of department or supervisor. Remember, that you like to call the shots, but you don't make the rules. *Greed* and *ruthlessness* are *traps* along the way you may fall into along the way to wealth and influence.

If anyone can achieve worldly success it has to be '*Eight*' individuals; they are shrewd characters who have the necessary *ambition*, *drive* and grim *determination* to get to the top. Big business will

beckon, and provided that they are astute in their business dealings, success just has to be around the corner.

Good judgment when it comes to money and commercial matters, and understands how to build and accumulate *material* wealth. Much of the success (or lack of it) comes from the ability (or inability) to judge character.

Very ambitious and goal oriented, and if the energy is not excessive you will no doubt express some of these traits. No one has more energy than an *Eight Expression* when there is a plan laid out and is starting to work. No one has more self-confidence either.

These individuals have the ability to *plan, initiate, and complete* projects; so are very dependable and determined.

If these people learn to exercise authority according to higher guidance, life will automatically put them in situations of authority and command. They have the skills and abilities to be used to build a better world. Often called into situations that have broken down and need to be revitalized. They can be a positive example of manifestation through creative visualization, and application for the good of mankind.

The *number eight* is very *materialistic* and *power* and *status* are desired. If these drives are inherently *negative* they have been taken to extreme. You must avoid the tendency to strain after money, material matters, status, or power, to the detriment of the other important factors in your life.

On a *negative* note; these people can become *stubborn* and *rigid*. Ambition has a way of becoming over-ambition, and may express an unreasonable impatience with the lack of progress. Can be too exacting, both of self and of others, and sometimes this can actually become intolerance.

Number Nine:

Potential lies in *mental* and *artistic* development for the benefit of *humanity*. A natural philanthropist because of compassion and human understanding. A wide ranging appeal and well trusted. Can be involved in many good causes at once that you lose focus. Need to prioritize and decide what you really can and can't take on. Can become carried away with romanticism which

can drain yourself emotionally and financially in the process. Impulsive and emotional you are prone to laugh one moment and cry the next. Your own feelings sometimes confuse you. Quite youthful all your life. Lovely personality which makes a lasting impression. Make good receptionists, salesperson, artist, preacher, correspondent.

Talents center on humanistic interest and approaches. Likes to *help others* and were intended to the '*big brother* or *big sister*' type. Operates best when following own feelings and compassions, and allows the self to be sensitive to the needs of others. These people work well with others, and have the potential to inspire.

Could very successfully teach or counsel. General nursing and organizations devoted to animal welfare may hold a strong attraction, as does the field of medicine where they will be faced with many testing situations.

Creative ability, imagination, intuition, and *artistic talent* (often latent) of the highest order are present in this expression. It is quite possible that all these capabilities are not used or developed (or even realized). Some talents may have been used at an earlier time of your life; and some may still be latent. Needs to be aware of capabilities, so they can be used at appropriate times.

If these people are capable of achieving the potential of the natural expression in this life, they are capable of much human understanding and have a lot to give others. Personal ambitions are likely to be kept in a very positive perspective, never losing sight of an interest in people, and a sympathetic, tolerant, broad-minded and compassionate point of view.

Quite idealistic, and disappointed at the lack of perfection in the world. A strong awareness of own feelings as well as those of others. *Friendships, affection*, and *love* are extremely important.

Underdeveloped or *ignored* the *negative* side of the *Nine Expression* can come to light as being very *selfish* and *self-centered*. If you do not actively involve yourself with work that benefits others, you may tend to express just the opposite characteristics. It is your role to be very involved with other people and their needs, but it may be difficult for you to achieve this role. *Aloofness, lack of involvement*, and a *lack* of *sensitivity* mark the low road of this Expression. There can sometimes be an explosive temperament and this should be kept under control, for it could undo all the good created by the selfless acts.

There is also a need to be watchful of tier physical energy levels, taking the time to rest when

exhaustions sets in. Failure to do so, by pushing to complete a task within a given time frame, may lead to serious health problems.

Number Eleven:

Refined, dreamy, intuitive, perceptive, and often has a look that says, "I am in another world". Not adapted to the business world, due to the fact that basically tends to be too *high strung* and *impractical*. Always *follow your hunches*, as you are *intuitive*. Before becoming the leader you would like to be, you need to learn to mingle with the people and share your knowledge.

This number is concerned with *idealistic* concepts rather than *spiritual* issues. Accordingly it can be a number with potentials that are somewhat difficult to live up to. You have the capacity to be inspiration, and the ability to lead by your own example.

An inborn inner strength and awareness can make for an excellent teacher, social worker, philosopher or adviser. Very aware and sensitive to the highest sense of the environment no matter what work is chosen.

Intuition is very strong; in fact many psychic people and those involved in occult studies have this number expression. Possesses a good mind with analytical ability. Because of this they can probably succeed in any line of work chosen, but prefers to be out of the business world; although can succeed there, oddly due to the unusual and original approach. On the whole though prefers working with own ideals rather than *dollars* and *cents*.

Careers such as those, which deal in illusion, such as theatre of cinema, the world of dance, or the instruction of others in philosophical pursuits would be ideal for them. Thinking is *long term*, and is able to *grasp* the far-reaching effects of *actions* and *plans*. Deeply concerned and supportive of art, music, or of beauty in any form.

Negative attitudes associated with this expression include a continuous sense of *nervous tension*; may be too *sensitive* and *temperaments*. Tends to *dream* a lot and may be more a *dreamer* than *doer*. Can become *impractical* when *fantasy* and *reality* become *intermingled*. Wants to spread the illumination of own knowledge to others regardless of their desire or need.

Number Twenty-two:

Poised, self-assured, full of *nervous energy*, and generally look "the *picture of perfection*". Has high ideals, is *philosophical* and also *logical*. Wants to be a *Master Builder*, has ideas and wants to put them into action. Can accomplish anything puts mind to. Looked to for *guidance, intuition* and *sill* makes this person very valuable.

The key word here is *Master Builder*. A very hard number to fully live up to because it is capable of such great accomplishment.

Can be extremely capable at whatever work chosen to do in life. Especially equipped to handle large-scale undertakings in the *material* world. These people possess unique qualities and often very unorthodox approaches to problem solving. Apt to be a strong leader and one who is not afraid to lead in new directions. Perceptions are well beyond the norm.

Endowed with the most practical approach, but this practical or material sense is tempered with an awareness of non-material forces. Very much the idealist, with the skills to build and develop for the good of mankind. Inner strength is clearly visible, and if developed, this strength will possess the charisma to attract a following.

There is a need for balances; something that may be hard to retain. If expressed in a *negative* manner, there may be accentuation of unorthodox methods to the point of eccentricity. Can also be very *dominating* and *overbearing*. This can also be the number of the *Master Black Magician*.

Number Thirty-three:

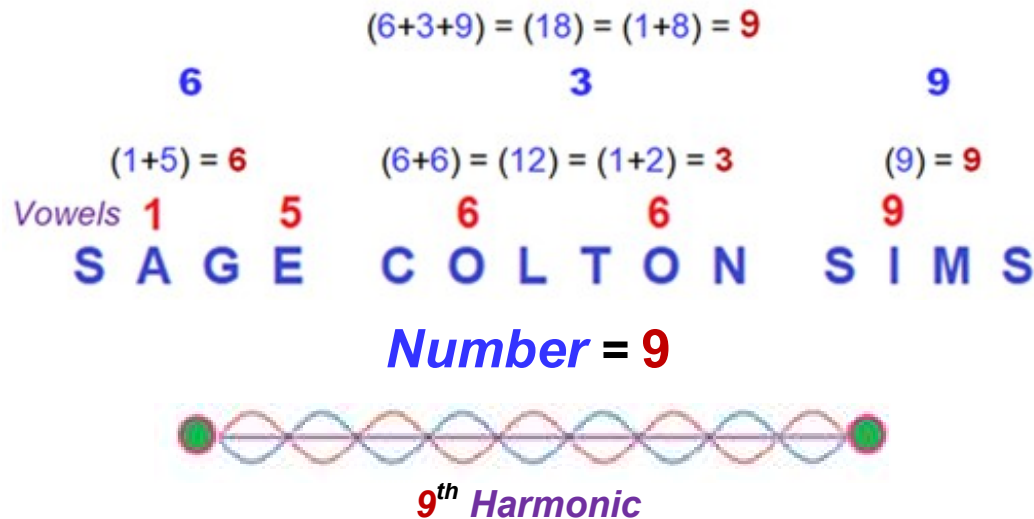
Possessing an inner knowledge, which causes you to be little concerned with the *material* world. Has a quiet, authoritative manner of speaking which commands respect. Real job is to be of service to mankind through *example* and *teaching*. A man (woman) for all mankind.

The Soul's Urge:

This *harmonic* comes from the *vowels* in our name. It shows an insight to our deepest hearts desires; our urges and values. It is a very wise part of ourselves. It is the part of each of us that has the deepest feelings and sheds light on what you *most desire in this lifetime* be it consciously or unconsciously. This *harmonic* is a major part of our core as it beautifies and rounds out our character. By *harmonizing* it with other core parts we can fully express who we are.

The *Soul's Urge* is also called the *Heart's Desire*, or *Inner Self*. This number is the *desire* of the *soul*, the goals and inner motivations in life. It reminds you of how you need to live this life in the best possible way to achieve *satisfaction*, *success* and *fulfillment* of your true destiny. Of course, your actual lifestyle, present emotional situation or other external circumstances can conceal the *harmonic*. Once understood, it can be used in a constructive and positive way.

This is quite an important number as it may indicate how you handle your *Expression* number. We will continue with Sage's Chart.



Sage's *Expression* or *Destiny Number* and his *Heart's Desire Number* are both equal to the *Number 9*; to refresh your memory on the qualities of the *Number 9* refer to his *Destiny Number* on Page 61. *The Qualities are preserved no matter the Aspect.*

Soul's Urge or Heart's Desire Interpretations

Keyword-Type Interpretations

Number One:

Urge is to be a boss or a star; the center of attention; wants to do things quickly and own way; likes to work alone; does not allow anyone to own or dictate them; try not to be resentful of others. Watch out for impatience and boastfulness. Likes to do things in a big way. The Number *One* soul likes to be number 1 in all things.

Motivated to lead and direct. Likes to work alone, without supervision, or with subordinates. Takes pride in abilities and wants to be recognized for them. Seeks opportunities to display strength and usefulness; wants to create and originate. Prefers to manage the main issues leaving the details

to others. Chose this harmonic for its thrust and initiative, necessary to accomplish innovation and renovations. This can lead to impatience with people who are resistant to change.

Ambitious and determined; a leader seeking opportunities. Honest and loyal. Attainment oriented and driven to success. A loyal friend and extremely if not strictly fair in business dealings.

In the *negative*: Prone to try to dominate situations and people. (home, family, spouse and at work) Does not have strong emotions. Can be boastful and egotistic. Has no time for trifling details, and can be too critical. Must develop friendliness and sincere interest in people.

Number Two:

Urge is to seek out *associations, partnerships, marriage* and/or *companionship*. Craves *love* and *understanding*; is much better as a *follower* rather than a leader. Enjoys *comfort*, but not particularly *ambitious*. To be *friendly*, but *sensitive* and *emotional*, and good when giving *love* and *affection*.

Motivation is centered on friendships, partnerships and companionship. Wants to work with others as a part of a team. Leadership is not important, but cooperation and contribution to the team effort is. Willing to work to achieve a harmonious environment with sensitive, congenial people. Capacity for discretion, others of power will rely on this to handle responsibility and influence behind the scenes. Sometimes inclination for *tact* will prevent you from speaking *true feelings*. Gains come through negotiation not force.

This *Soul Urge* number can strengthen their natural spiritual and psychic sensitivity, by a study of the symbolic and metaphysical sciences, such as Tarot, numerology, astrology, palmistry, Kabbalah, I Ching, dreams etc. Often develop into fine clairvoyants and psychic channels. *Sympathetic, concerned* and very *devoted*. Very sensitive to others and very tactful and diplomatic. Rather *emotional. Persuasive*, but in a very quiet way, never forceful to get what you want. Makes really close friendships because is so *loving* and *affectionate*.

In the *negative*: May be oversensitive, easily hurt by others. Timid or fearful. Too easy-going for own good.

Number Three:

Urge is to live life as and *artform*, full of grace and beauty, with you at the center spreading happiness. Social popularity is extremely important to you. You love to entertain as well as being entertained. *Friendly*, but *sensitive* and *emotional*, and good at giving love and affection. You like to have lots of friends, and seek beauty in all *people* and *surroundings*.

Motivation is self-expression, and enjoying life to its fullest. To participate in active social life and enjoy a large circle of friends. Wants to be in the limelight, expressing artistic or intellectual talents. Has word skills; speaking, writing, acting and singing. Creative expression is reflected in the add little touch given to hobbies, work and avocation's of life. Benefits from an in-depth study of the yin and yang energy patterns. Has a knack for recognizing the needed touch to bring harmony and balance into a situation which is out of balance.

Many artists with this *Soul Urge* are entering into an inner plane awakening, producing psychic or cosmic art. (can be paintings, or music, or the written word). Should speak from the heart. Loves people, pets and children. Friendly, outgoing and always very social. Decidedly upbeat attitude that is rarely discouraged. Good mental and emotional balance. Intuitive insight, thus, very highly creative and inspirational gifts. Outstanding trait of self-expression, regardless of the field of endeavor.

Negative: Too *easy going* and *optimistic*. Easily *scattered* and may accomplish *very little*. Can be a *non-stop talker*.

Number Four:

Urge is to seek out *order*, and are a lover of *tradition*. To be steady, have a regular routine in your *home* and *work*. You want to give *dependability*, and *expect* it too. *Speculation*, *change* and *innovation* are not an interest to you; you only want to deal with what is proven. You are skeptical of emotion or intuitive responses in both yourself and others. You want *relationships* to be *deep* and *long lasting*, based on *loyalty* and *trust*. Frivolity leaves you cold. Try to cultivate a broader point of view, and let go of the outworn, as your rigidity and dislike of change can make you stubborn and limits your viewpoint. Avoid being a *tightwad*.

Strives for a stable life. Follows a rather orderly pattern and systematic approach in all endeavors. Inner desire to serve others in a methodical and diligent manner. Solid, conventional and well regulated. Somewhat disturbed by innovation and sudden changes. Sacrifices much time and

effort if believes in the work/cause they are involved with. Happy to do work that is not glamorous or attracts public attention. Often a *deep* within *urge* will compel you to seek out the work, which you can do with quality, to serve the "*Plan*".

Excellent at *organizing*, *systematizing*, and *managing*. Establishes order and maintains it. *Responsible*, *reliable* and always *practical*. Highly analytical, can see a way through all situations and has a clear view of the issues. Sincere, and conscientious.

Negative:

Rigid, stubborn and narrow-minded. Hides feelings, or not aware of feelings. Try to see the big picture rather than becoming to involved with detail. Don't be afraid to take chances.

Number Five:

Urge is to seek constant change in all things, love to travel and follow the easy road in life. You demand personal freedom in every respect, which could make you impatient with people around you that seem to be very slow and set in their ways. Easily adaptable to any situation you seek many varied interests. An insatiable appetite for people wanting to make new friends and new lovers all the time. You enjoy sensual stimulation such as sex, food, drink and drugs.

Urge to follow a life of freedom, excitement, adventure and unexpected happening. Travel and freedom to roam is appealing. Very much the adventurer at heart. Not really concerned about the future or getting ahead in life, can be superficial and unmotivated.

Large range of activities experienced makes these people great teachers, often drawing from personal experience. Much wisdom comes from personal contact with all different kinds of people rather than from studies. Responsibility to share personal growth with others. Be proud of the strength and knowledge you have to share.

Very adaptable and versatile. Natural resourcefulness and enthusiasm that is recognized as progressive with a good mind and active imagination. Natural inclination to be a pacesetter. Attracted to the unusual and fast paced.

Negative: Overly restless and impatient at times. Dislikes routine work, and may tend to jump from activity to activity, without finishing anything. Difficulty with responsibility. Doesn't want to be tied down to a relationship, may find it hard to commit to one person.

Number Six:

Urge is to be a *peacemaker*, and has an inner love of *family* and *home*. To be very understanding of others and listen to their problems. Accepting responsibility is also desirable. *Harmony* is the key here. Enjoys domestic responsibility, and want a family or fiends who depend on you. Enjoys working with color, texture and shape to make beautiful clothes and furnishings.

Would like to be appreciated for ability to handle *responsibility*.

Home and *family life* is a strong focus, sometimes the *strongest* focus of life.

Seeks a perfect mate, and can become disappointed. Remember mates are often chosen to help learn a lesson.

Friendship, *love* and *appreciation* are high priorities for a happy life. A lot of diplomatic tendencies, and are able to rectify and balance situations with an innate skill. Very important to have *harmony* at all *times*. People are *comfortable* around these people, and willing to share their conflicts and *suffering*. Many *sixes* open their inner awareness to become counselors. (often dealing with past life traumas). Intellectual outlook is broad and flexible, but lifestyle and emotional outlook can tend to be conservative.

A huge capacity for responsibility; always there to assume more than your share of the load. Well known for generous, understanding and deep sympathetic attitude. Very giving of love, affection, and emotional support.

Inclination to teach or serve the community in other idealistic ways. Natural abilities to help people. Artistic and creative leanings.

Negative:

Strong sympathetic attitude, but this makes it easy to become too emotional. Sometimes the intention to help can be overdone, and becomes interference, and an attitude that is too protective, rather than helpful. Can be taken advantage of. Represses own needs so can cater to the demands of others. If overloaded by others demands can become resentful.

Number Seven:

A preference to *live within yourself*. Tendency to be *philosophical*, *intellectual*, and keep inner *thoughts to yourself*. A conservationist, and prone to live in the clouds, not down to earth. You may tend to seek silence, *quiet meditation* and *much prefer to live alone*. If you had a choice of

vantage point from which to live your life, it would be an ivory tower where you could sit undisturbed, far away from the maddening crowd. You need a place where you can meditate or commune with nature. Because of your thirst of knowledge, the occult and science interests you, and you are not afraid to go beyond the bounds to prove your theories. You do worry about being *lonely* though, even though you want privacy. You are deeply emotional but afraid to show it, others need to get to know you before they can love you. Cultivate *understanding* and *sympathy*, and *avoid fear* and *depression*.

Fond of reading, and retreating to periods of being alone and away from the hustle and bustle of the outer world. Has a vast storehouse of evolutionary knowledge, and has come to share and enlighten. Is learning to set aside the rational, concrete mind of the lower self, not completely but just long enough to hear the communication from the universal mind. (*Meditation*). Enjoys probing the deeper realms of psychology, religion, science, philosophy, or metaphysical studies in an attempt to solve the deepest mysteries of man and universe. Has a tremendous inner wisdom or gift of spirit. Benefits from being out in nature to recharge batteries.

Subconscious emotional blocks must be overcome in order to accurately tap the intuitive mind. Likes to dream and develop idealistic understandings, to study and analyze, to gain knowledge and wisdom. Tends to be too back and withdrawn to really succeed in the business world, and will be more comfortable in circumstances that are tolerant of the reserved, analytical approach, and use the *mind* rather than the *physical* body.

Can be timid around others that are not known well, so casual conversation (chitchat) and socializing can be difficult.

Negative:

Being too introverted and isolated from others. Tends to repress emotions, making it difficult for others to understand this person. Selective with friends and doesn't adapt well to new environments easily. May have very strong opinions about own wisdom, which can surface as arrogance.

Number Eight:

Motivated by *power*, *control*, and *ambitions* are for *material* success, *position* and *authority*. Money is important; you want lots of it and the things you can buy with it. Whatever you do has to show some sort of profit, whether it be material gain or some advantage gained. Good judgment,

fair business practices and organizational efficiency are important to you. Your forte is being able to *control* your *emotional* and *physical impulses* while maintaining an executive kind of persona. High on physical and mental stamina. Always on time for an appointment no matter what you were doing. Feels great responsibility toward those around you is based on your need for their respect and loyalty. Need to develop a sense of justice and tolerance for those who are weaker and less efficient. Confident and courageous.

Natural flair for business and the challenges imposed by the commercial world. Power, status and success are important. Power is tempered by an ego need. Once you let go of this need, you will be recognized for just how powerful you are. Higher direction then will guide to through the complexity of decisions. Has stamina, poise, and confidence to achieve anything you set out to do. Dislikes weakness and inefficiency.

Has an excellent ability to recognize potential in others, and can use this gift either selfishly or genuinely to assist in the awakening of another's potential. Strong urges to supervise, organize and lead. Material desires. Look at your attitude to money. Is it more important to you than other values in life? Do you feel superior to those who have less? Once an Eight lets go of the need for money and accepts the universal flow, he will have as much as is required. Learn to give and use money with love, and the divine law of supply will come.

Good executive abilities, and also confidence, energy and ambition. Analytical mind and sound judgment; good judge of material values and human character. Self-controlled, rarely lets emotions cloud judgment. An organizer at heart, and likes to keep those beneath organized and on a proper track. Wants to lead , not to follow. Wants to be known for planning abilities and solid judgment.

Negative:

Dominating and exacting attitude. Tendency to be very rigid, sometimes stubborn.

Number Nine:

Seeks inner knowledge, and to be self-sacrificing and wants others to benefit from your experiences. Always ready to teach and to give without thought of self. As far as reincarnation is concerned your are an old soul, having been here many times before and have the capabilities of teaching others some of the knowledge you gained over many lifetimes.

Wants to give to others, usually in a humanitarian or philanthropic manner. Highly motivated to give friendship, affection and love. Generous in giving of knowledge and experience.

Very sharing urges, and likely has a great deal to share. Needs to learn to act in accordance with inner guidance. Dreams of a world where there is no misunderstanding, no criticism, no ego threats, or no other causes of disharmony and of distrust. Nines often develop into inspired artist, poets, inventors, or psychics.

Can be quite gullibility. Satisfaction in personal love does not always come easily because of a learning to move toward in impersonal, universal love. Nines dream of a utopian world.

Concern for others makes a very sympathetic and generous person with a sensitive and compassionate nature. Able to view life in broad and intuitive terms. Often expresses high ideals and inspirational approach to life. If able to fully realize the potential of this harmonic, will be a very self-sacrificing person who is able to give freely without concern of reward or return.

Negative:

May become too sensitive and express emotions strongly at times. Conflicts of personal ambitions and higher aims. Resents giving all the time, and perhaps rejects the idea. May often be disappointed in the lack of perfection in self and others.

Number Eleven:

Strongly urged to feel very idealistic and spiritual, would like to save the world. Has a tendency of great inner strength, and inventive mind. Intuitive, and need to follow own hunches. A dreamer, and not always practical (you live in a different world), remember not all are ready for your level of thinking. Has great visions and some day the world you see will be a reality. Learn to share more with those less fortunate than you, and most of all have faith.

Thinking and interests relate to the abstract, spiritual, and utopian dreams. Motivated toward idealistic concepts, and sharing of ideas and concepts with humanity. Not a number that is giving in a *material* or practical sense, but rather one who desires to help mankind with a more abstract commodity such as religion, spiritualism, occult studies or psychic abilities. Often make excellent channels and psychics, and often working with devic beings or inner plane guides.

Once your feet are planted in common sense, you may find yourself in a position of prominence. Dreams of a perfect world; highly idealistic and inspirational. Inner strength and devotion to beliefs

are extremely strong. Very good mind that is well equipped to handle the higher, more abstract forms of thought.

Negative:

Tendency to produce considerable amounts of nervous tension brought on by a very high level of awareness. Too sensitive and highly emotional. If the emotions and sensitivities are quite repressed this may add to even more to the sense of nervousness in the person. Not a very practical person because of the extreme idealism; and there can be a degree of self-deception. Very fixed ideas of right and wrong, and this can lead to an attitude of inflexibility.

Number Twenty-two:

Motivated to love all people and give help whenever and wherever needed. Wants to be beneficial to others, a master of any situation. Can be trusted and is respected for fairness. Master Builder if ideas, concepts, and spiritual awareness.

This is the *Master Builder*. Would like to use abilities in an important humanitarian undertaking, and has an innate desire to express the significant power felt in a concrete manner, as a builder, engineer, diplomat, etc. Wants to make a considerable contribution to the world.

Has a broad, universal outlook with a practical and common sense approach. High intelligence, with an unusual perception and awareness. High degree of diplomatic abilities and high ideals. Capable person and may possess special leadership abilities that can and should be developed. Respected and recognized for superior foresight and vision. Can recognize other highly capable workers and work with them on inner and outer planes toward fulfillment.

Negative:

High degree of nervous energy and a tendency to be very dominating. Often holds positions in many types of work prior to the call of service, which can foster a sense of inferiority. This then, causes an underestimation of worth and diminishing of capacities. Not all who possess the **22** energy use it to the greatest advantage; but it should be recognized that these energies are understandably the most difficult to focus and direct.

Number Thirty-three:

Always able to see the *inner beauty* of all *people* and *things*. You are capable (if fully aware) of living what most people can only preach. Others either love you deeply or hate you deeply because of a lack of understanding and feel threatened by your presence. Never thinking about yourself or what you have, therefore you find what you need just come to you.

The Personality

This *harmonic* is derived from the *consonants* in our full name. It shows how others attempt to see and direct us. It is how we project ourselves to other people and the world. It is a first impression others get when they first meet us. The Personality is also called the *Quiet Self*. We are all a blending of many *harmonics*. Sometimes a core aspect may stand out more than the others. Sometimes a part stays in the background as we recognize, express, and experience other parts. The ultimate experience of this lifetime is the synchronization and blending of all parts into a balanced, fully functioning, and expressive self.

As a (*simple*) example: The *Life Path* shows what type of *abilities* we have when choosing a vocation. The *Personality* is the first impression that will either get you the job or not. The *Soul Urge* shows what you truly want from this job, and what type of work environment you desire. The *Expression* or *Destiny Number* will determine how you do the job.

Number One:

Courageous and daring; you picture yourself as a leader and promoter of new things; distinctive. You come across as someone who is assured and independent. Likes to set styles not follow them. You admire strength, courage and determination in others and desire these qualities in yourself. Wants to be on top of any situation you find yourself in.

Individuality, self-reliance and originality. Driven by a strong will power, and with a definite goal in mind has enormous productivity. Without such intent, less than enthusiastic and will settle for adequate accomplishment. Can be self-centered and wants to be first in all things.

Can become selfish and contrary if things don't go as they should. Finds it difficult to accept orders and may go against the wishes of the group, just to assert identity. Hides insecurity behind brash and assertive outer expression. Does not like to take to advice, but loves to give directions.

If convinced of a better way of doing something, you are ardent in praise and can quickly stir up enthusiasm in those about you. Natural drive to the top and seeks positions of supervision, leadership, and authority. Can be rather blunt, often wily, dignified, and communication is to the point. Prefers one to one friendships rather than having many which are superficial.

Enjoys being around achievers and go-getters. Best to maintain a spouse or close companion who is also strong-willed, supportive, and patient. Although individuality is important, likes the security of a steady relationship to really enjoy and get the most out of life. Romance is direct and straightforward and intense.

In the *negative*:

In the *negative*:

Very trustworthy. Comfortable with and attractive to the opposite sex. A perpetual romantic, often entangled in adventurous affairs. Life can be full of incredible and intriguing experiences; if talents are used to teach, write, or counsel others; which provides a rich potpourri of anecdotes. Quick to pick things up, but needs practicality to balance imagination. In romance, enjoys colorful surroundings and cheerful verbal interplay. In the *negative*:

Thrifty, orderliness, and prudence are given top rating on list of priorities. Self-image is often based on accomplishments and achievements of your family. Property, proper social standing and success are very much related to personal security. Would not take risks which might jeopardize that security when subconscious instincts are active. Takes great pride in work. Does not waste time; tinkers around the home, car, or where there is a need. Likes routine. Imagination is not a strong point. Practicality, organizational poise, technical adroitness, and industry helps to get ahead in life. Most comfortable when working for an industry or cause in which you can put your trust and esteem. Will gladly work at best to help others; this can cause others to take advantage. Steadfast, honest, and generally dependable.

Does not find it easy to mingle with others, trading small talk. Fixed attitudes draw very opinionated definitions of right and wrong without much tolerance for people considered in the latter category. If the fixed baseline is shaken can become scattered and defenseless. Reaction to that condition is to be defensive, argumentative, and stubborn. Does not rush into anything brashly, which gives security, but many self-initiated kicks in the rear are deserved for opportunities left untried. Does not find it easy to enjoy the fun in life spontaneously. Has to work at it! Is romantically ardent, but control passion.

Loyal and enjoy a constancy in companionship and technique. Does not play the field in the search for a compatible mate. Marriage provides security and solace. A productive spouse and children help to build the ego. Loyalty and sacrifice come easy, when you are proud of those you protect.

Harmonious careers include electricians, craftsmen, builders, chemists, scientists, farmers, naturalists, bankers, military people, accountants, office workers and police.

In the *negative*:

Does not take much time for fun and pleasure, preferring to be left alone to complete the task at hand. If does not enjoy work then everyone around will know. Enjoys the company of the opposite sex are usually surrounded by friends of both sexes. Tends not to probe deeply below the surface and become uneasy when there is an attempt to delve into your psyche.

In romance, flirtatious, fickle, and fun. Prefers sexual variety in mates and methods. Will not be tied down, but fun to be with while around. In marriage requires a lot of latitude for varied interest. Likes a mate who is versatile and active. Athletic and outdoor activities are important to physical well being.

Does not find it easy to adjust to the demands of family and home; but if content, can be an entertaining and colorful companion. Suitable vocations are entertainers, civil servants, speakers, salespeople, travel consultants, tour guides, athletes, and circus people are just a few.

In the *negative*:

Empathy can be used very subtly to manipulate others by aggravating their insecurities. Can be somewhat of a martyr and tend to fight lost causes with zest.

Number Seven:

Pictures themselves in a library filled with rare books, exquisite art and elegant antique furnishings, where many come to learn the wisdom from their lips. Spends time in quiet meditation, wearing a long robe that befits a mystic whose mind contains the wisdom of the ancients. Tries to live quietly and peacefully. Prefers to live in the country, away from the hustle and bustle of the city. Prefers to live alone, but when with people only enjoys small groups and preferably intellectuals. The power of the mind interests you.

Intellectuality, skepticism, wisdom, detachment, and aloofness. Wisdom lies within the memory of all you have been, and prefers to go within for solace rather than to turn to others. Learn to relax.

Seeks an able partner as a spouse. Enjoys all the trappings of a good life, status symbols as indication of success. Careers and positions include stockbrokers, executives, charity organizer, engineers, athletes, management, and vocational teachers.

In the *negative*:

Can use others for personal gain. When too detached from emotion, attitude toward others can become hostile, sullen, even intimidating. Lack of regard can cause ruthlessness and can develop into seeing another person as something to be used for own gains.

Number Nine:

Filled with love of humanity and a desire to serve, regardless of personal cost. You would like to help put an end to all suffering. Highly emotional, you understand suffering and attract many that

need comfort and advice. Like a spectator you look down on the struggles and mistakes you have made in the past and overcome.

You sacrifice generosity, tolerance, idealism, and altruism. Are dreamers and optimists who set a tone for hope and aspiration for the world. Live in an inner world of idea, ideals, and dreams. Finds it hard to be practical; although does not pursue material possessions, seem to be provided with what is needed.

Not at home in business unless it offers an opportunity to serve the greater cause for mankind. Temperament is artistic, mystical, and poetic. There is a wholesome spirit of humbleness because of an awareness of greater cosmic forces at work in life and in the universe. Mind works in generalities rather than in detail.

Emotionally impressionable and generous, which lets others impose easily on your time and energy. You must learn to overcome urges of envy, spite, and revenge, by learning the law of forgiveness and release. Once you have learned to let go and flow with higher consciousness, you are very enlightened and inspired. You often have the chance to travel and experience life first hand. Number Twenty-two:

Desires to make the kind of improvements that would be of benefit to all of mankind. Find a way to reach the peoples of the world and bring all together as friends. Would love to be a diplomat or statesman in order to help bring worldwide peace.

This personality is very similar to the **four**. Often attracted to institutions or large movements, which aim to bring mankind's greater cosmic destiny into form. Capable of uniting and working with people to bring the New Age into form on Earth. May go through many menial and unimportant positions in their early years, but this can be a test, which teaches them humbleness, and respect for those who will do little jobs later on under their direction.

In the *negative*:

Can sometimes become greedy, lustful for power, or aligned with darker forces. Sometimes feels that he has some added responsibility, and until higher awareness is opened can wander around with a great feeling of self-importance and little to show for it.

Number Thirty-three:

Greatest desire is to bring spiritual awareness to the world. Wants to know, understand, and live all spiritual truths. True believer in freedom, and a lover of the outdoors. Dream is to have everyone understand the true meaning of life and spirit.

The Letter 'Y'

The "y" seems to cause a bit of trouble when trying to understand whether or not it is a vowel or a consonant. Different people do use different rules to ascertain which it should be. Some numerologists use it ALWAYS as a vowel, some NEVER use it as a vowel, and some use it only when there is no other vowel in the name.

This concept does make it quite difficult as the normal is to ask *five* different people and you'll get *five* different answers. The general consensus is too "iffy" for me, however my preference is to stay true to the *Digital Root* System which gives a definite number for each letter of the alphabet, however you may use whichever suits your preference.



Conclusion

We have covered the *five* (5) *aspects*, their interpretations and the *Digital Root* math in Numerology. There is one other task left to be completed, the "*summation*." This can be accomplished by constructing a "*Mini-Chart*." A *Mini-Chart* is a list of all the aspects in order of construction along with their numbers. *Sum* the numbers in the *Mini-Chart* and carefully review them. In the *Mini-Chart* shown below, Sage has a *life Path* of *six* (6), a *Birth-Date* of *seven* (7) and each of the other three (*Destiny Number*, *Heart's Desire*, and *Personality*) are a *nine* (9). The *summation* is the number *four* (4). $(6+7+9+9+9) = (40) = (4+0) = 4$. There are *two* situations involved with this summation, *first* "What does the value *four* (4) mean and *second*, how is it connected to the *three nines* (9) in the chart? I will leave these questions for you to answer. The answer can be found in the text of this manuscript. With a little *intuition* it won't be hard to figure out.
